

INFORMAL CROSSINGS

- Not controlled
- Pose security risk
- Established taxi ranks
- Easy access for illegal foreigners
- Pakistanis, Indians Chinese etc use these point to enter
- Local Chiefs regard these crossings as formal

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Appoint 20 Immigration Officers immediately at PCO Lebombo
- Appoint 10 Immigration Officers immediately at PCO Oshoek
- Appoint 3 Immigration Officers immediately at PCO Mahamba
- Appoint 3 Immigration Officers immediately at PCO Jeppes Reef
- Accommodation be addressed at all PCO
- Eg Park Homes
- Alternatively appointments be from surrounding area (to alleviate lack of accommodation)
- One Stop Border Post be championed at Lebombo and Oshoek

RECOMMENDATIONS INFORMAL CROSSINGS

- Borderline patrols be improved
- Inspectorate be capacitated
- Informal Crossings be dealt with at Bi-lateral meetings
