

In response to your letter dated 06 June 2007 referring to the above-mentioned draft Bill, the Local Government Portfolio Committee met on Thursday, 07 June 2007 in order to consider the said Draft Bill.

The Committee then decided to note the Draft Bill and that it is not in the position to hold public hearings at this stage due to time constraints. However, the Committee has agreed that once the Draft Bill enters the NCOP cycle, it will then consider the necessary compliance with S 118 of the Constitution in terms of public involvement. Therefore at this stage, this Committee cannot give a view on this Draft Bill.
