
The Petition of the undersigned ¹

Respectfully sheweth: That²

The matters below be referred to the Parliamentary Portfolio on Police.

- A) On the 05th September 2020, my late husband was informed by senior police officials that his phone was being "pinged" / tracked. He informed me of this on the same day. My husband was fuming about this and wanted to know what was going to be done to secure his safety. It has now also come to light that Gauteng Hawks Head Brigadier Ebrahim Kadwa drafted a report containing the information regarding the "pinging" of my husband's phone. This report was hand deliver to National Hawks Head General Godfrey Lebeya and Crime Intelligence Head Major General Peter Jacobs on the 06th September 2020. On the 16th September 2020, my husband received a call from General Lincoln informing him of extensive "pinging" of his phone on that particular day. The question I would like the Committee to address is what was done by National Hawks head General Godfrey Lebeya and Crime Intelligence Head Major General Peter Jacobs from the 06th September 2020 until the 18th September 2020 when my husband was assassinated. I am of the opinion that this was a two-week period in which necessary protocols could have been put in placed and possibly saved my husband's life. I deem this as gross negligence.
- B) On the 13th November 2019 my husband informed me that there was yet again another hit on his life. Due to this threat, my family was afforded with police guarding from the 13th November 2019. Whilst under police guarding, on the 23rd November 2019 there was an attempted hand grenade attack at our home and police guarding was increased. To our shock the guards were removed on the 19th December 2019 without notification. My family and I were living in fear as the attack with the hand grenade happened whilst we still had the police guarding. Upon Minister Bheki Cele's visit the 19th September 2020, he confirmed that an investigation would be conducted to clarify why the guards were removed. To date, my family and I have not received any clarity on this matter. It is for this reason that I would like the Committee to address this matter.
- C) I would like Parliament /portfolio committee to address the following Questions Please: Why despite continuous threats on my late husband life no official protection was ever provided He submitted documentation supporting this in 2018. Despite the hand grenade attempt in 2019 still nothing was done , and even after reports confirming the tracking/pinging of his phone still nothing was done to ensure the safety of my late husband .
