**REPLY:**

The security breach was not reported in the SA Police Service Annual Report 2019/20 as the President's farm in Phala-Phala was not protected by SAPS Presidential Protection Service. Phala-Phala farm only became the responsibility of SAPS in late 2020 and therefore 2021/2022 financial year 1<sup>st</sup> quarter it became part of reporting.
