
International Character of the War:


Director of the War Museum of the Boer Republics, Tokkie Pretorius, says in his preface "Kessler's book represents an opportunity to reshape the format of history taught in schools to accommodate the forgotten and unknown story of the black concentration camps. Until recently some Afrikaners in South Africa claimed a sole martyrdom, arising from the terrible deaths of 26 370 Afrikaner women and children in the concentration camps. Kessler's book shows that view of the past to have been too narrow. He documents the deaths of more than 21 000 black men, women and children in the camps established by the British in South Africa. There was a shared martyrdom between black and white and the suffering in the camps was something that united black and white."
