RE: REPORT ON ISSUES EMANATING FROM THE SELECT COMMITTEE BRIEFING

1. BACKGROUND

The purpose of this report is to account on issues emanating from the Select Committee on Security and Constitutional Development Briefing on the Strategic Plan, Annual Performance Plan and 2013/14 Budget of the IPID. As per the request of the Select Committee the report will give a brief overview of the state of the IPID in different provinces. The report will mainly focus on the on the breakdown of IPID investigators per province, the number of offices in each province and the overall statistical information regarding the IPID case intake.

A comprehensive report on statistics will be presented as part of the Half-Yearly Report to be tabled in Parliament in the next few weeks. The Directorate wish to request the Select Committee an opportunity to present detailed statistical information once it has tabled its Half-Yearly Report. The reason for this request is that the Directorate is busy auditing statistics and verifying information received from various provinces. The report as requested will only give preliminary statistics at the national level.

2. COMPLAINT FROM SAPS MEMBERS AGAINST GENERAL SIBIYA

The Directorate has considered the contents of the document tabled by Honourable Bloem with respect to a number of allegations against General Sibiya. The allegations are currently under investigation and the Directorate will inform the Select Committee of its findings as soon as it is practically possible.

3. PROVINCES

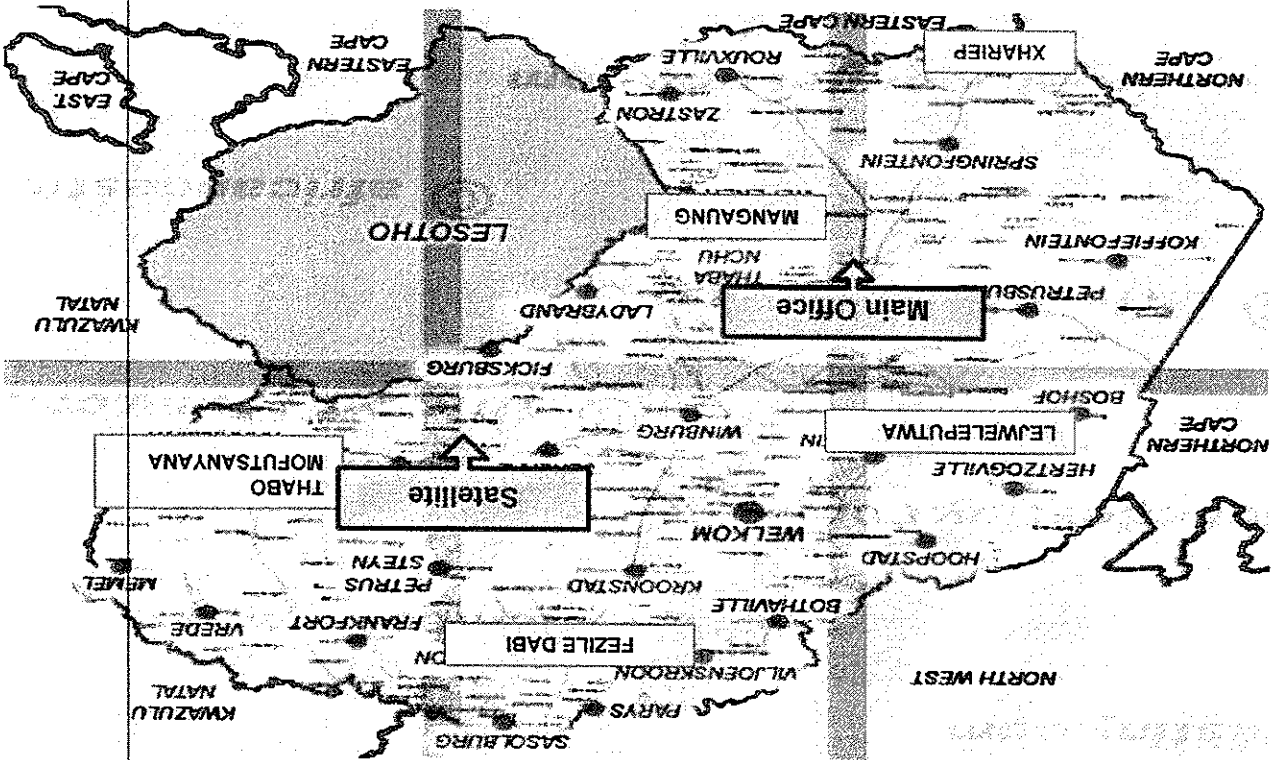
The preliminary statistics show that the number of cases received by the Directorate in the 2012/13 financial year is 6 684 cases. The table below shows the number of SAPS members per province, the 2012/13 IPID case intake or workload per province and the number of IPID investigators per province as at 31st March 2013:

2.2. Free State

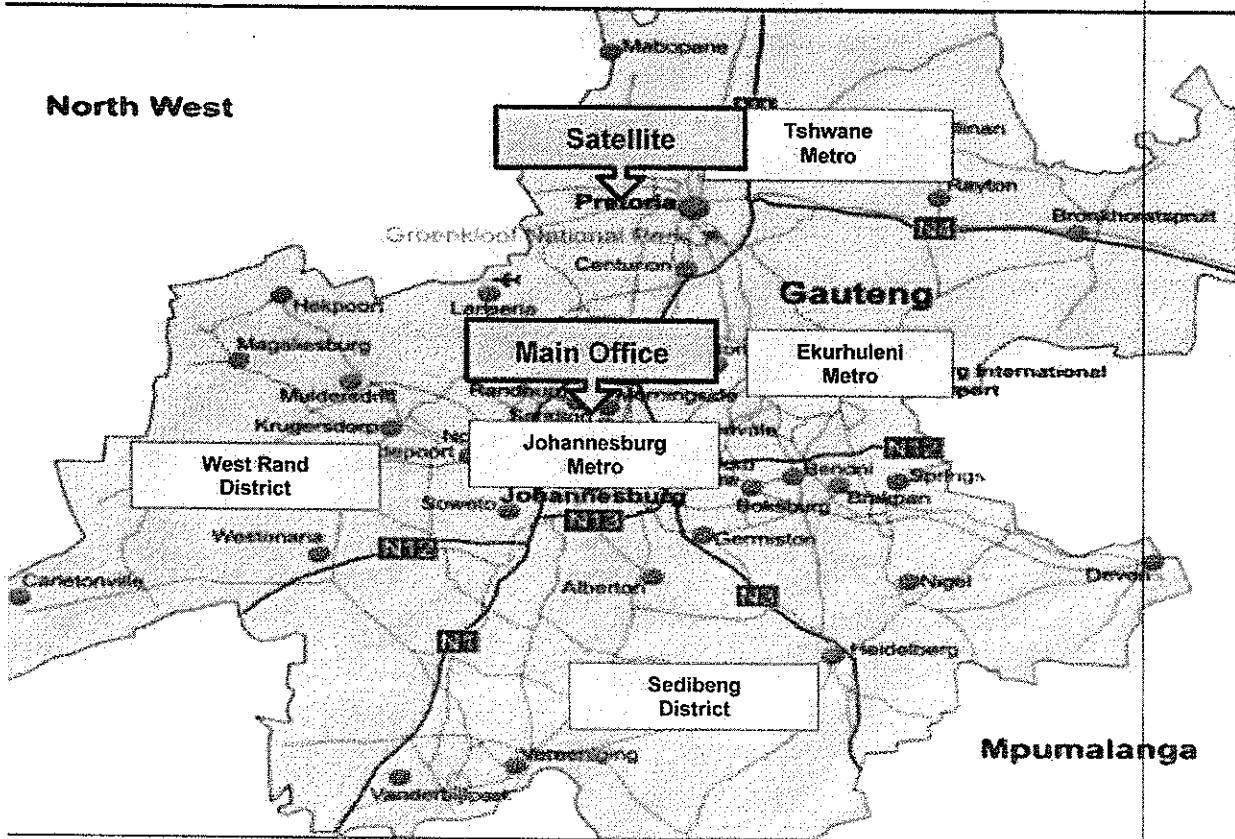
The IPID has two offices in the Free State, the main office (provincial office) is in Bloemfontein and the satellite office is in Bethlehem. The Directorate is in a process of moving this satellite office to Phuthaditjhaba, Qwaqwa as a result of the high percentage of case intake in the area and the fact that Qwaqwa is the district head office of the Thabo Mufutsanyana District and a lot of government offices are based there. In addition, the office will assist the IPID to serve rural communities better.

The IPID has two offices in this province, the provincial office is based in Johannesburg and the satellite office is in Pretoria.



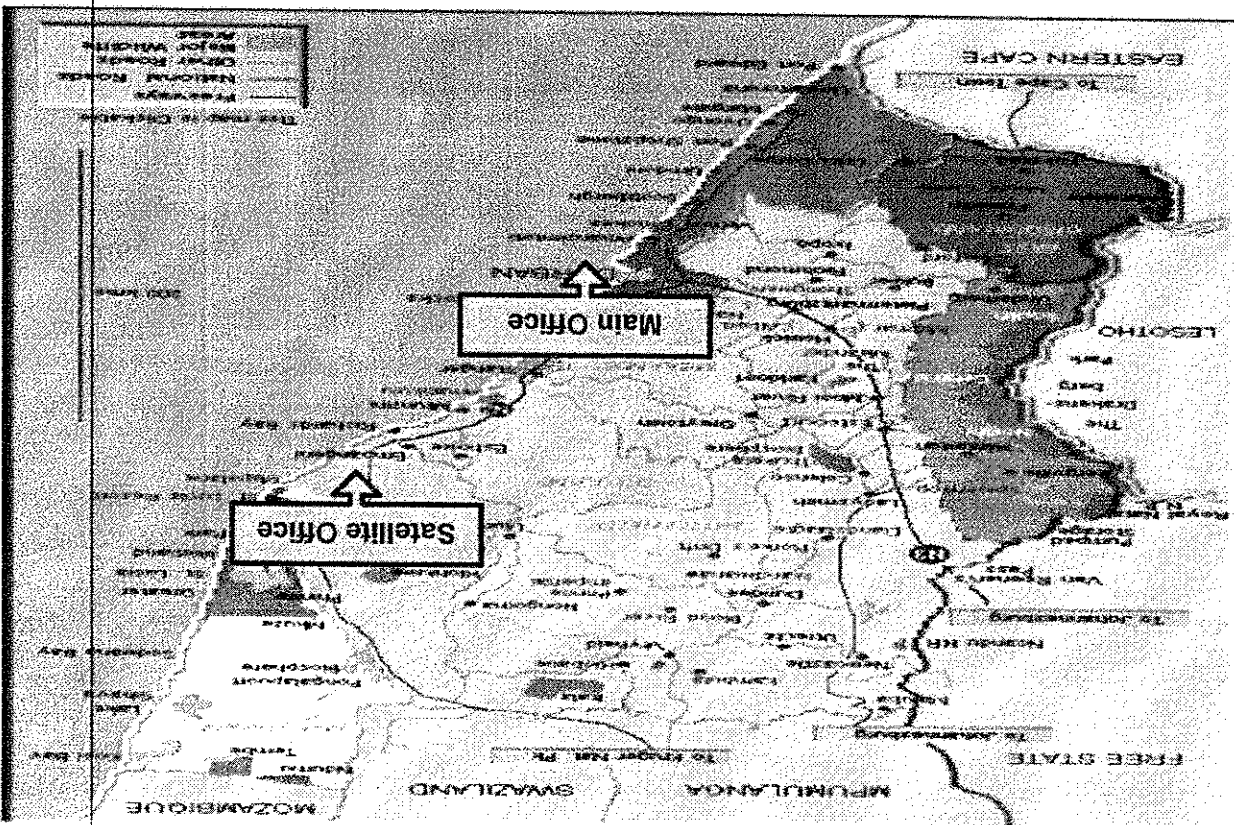

2.4. Kwazulu-Natal

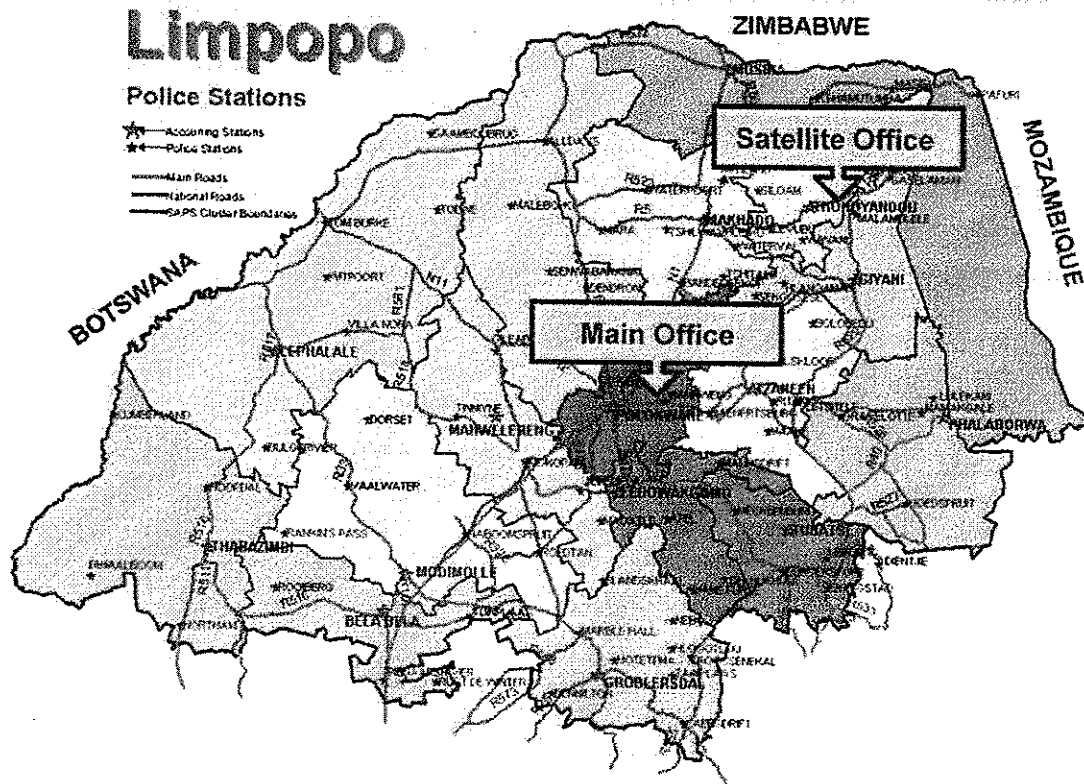
The IPID has two offices in the province, the provincial office is based in Durban, eThekwini Metro and the satellite office is based in Empangeni, uThungulu District.

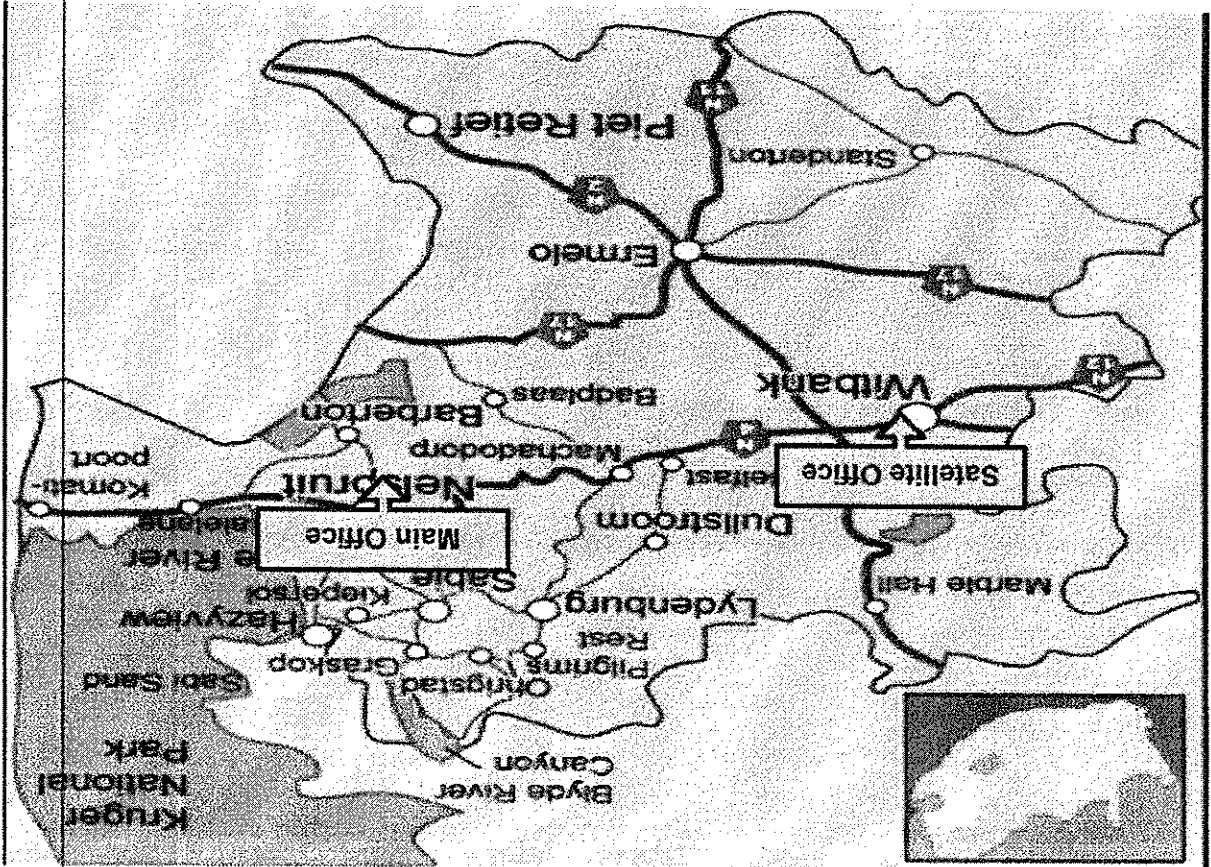

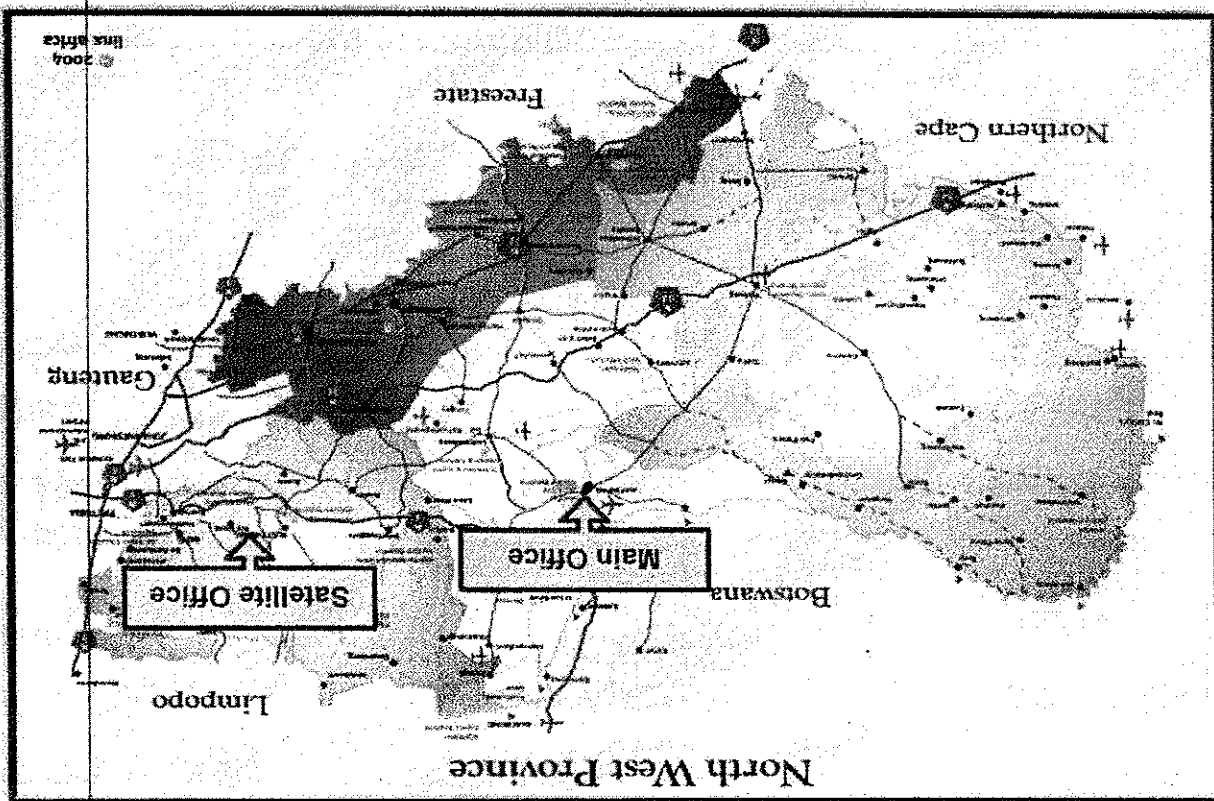

2.8. North West

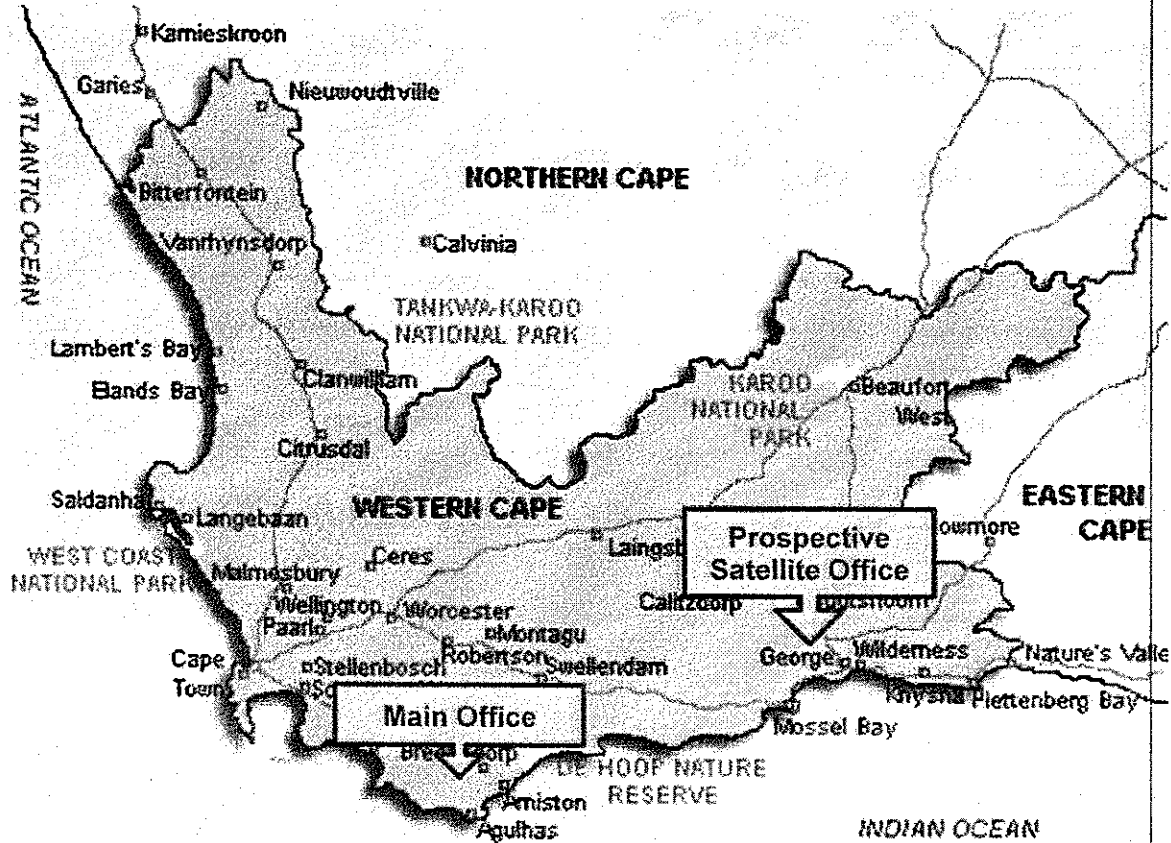

The IPID has only one office in this province based in Bellville, Cape Town Metro. The process of establishing a satellite in George, Eden District is currently underway.


