#### **INTRODUCTION**

The Parliamentary Committee of the General Council of the Bar of South Africa has reviewed the Judicial Matters Amendment Bill [B7-2013], and suggest the following:

#### 1. Ad clause 6(a)

In the first line, after the word "sentences", we suggest the insertion of the word "[on]" to indicate its omission from the current text of the statute.

#### 2. Ad clause 8(a)

We suggest the insertion of the words "in writing" after the word "applicant".

# 3. **Ad clause 8(b)**

In the last line, we suggest the deletion of the word "be", and that it be replaced with the word "remain".

#### 4. **Ad clause 8(c)**

We suggest the insertion of the words "in writing" after the word "applicant".

# 5. Ad clause 8(d)

We again suggest the insertion of the words "in writing" after the word "Service".

#### 6. Ad clause 45(a)

We suggest the insertion of the words "in writing" after the word "applicant".

# 7. Ad clause 45(b)

We suggest that in the last line, the word "be" be deleted, and replaced with the word "remain".

# 8. Ad clause 45(c)

We suggest the insertion of the words "in writing" after the word "applicant".

# 9. Ad clause 45(d)

We suggest the insertion of the words "in writing" after the word "Service".

10. Save as aforesaid, we make no adverse comment on any of the provisions, as they might affect the legal profession or the administration of justice or fundamental constitutional rights.
