

FINAL MANDATE: BROAD-BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT AMENDMENT BILL [B42D-2012]

#### (Section 76 Bills)

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism, Hon G Parker, tables the Committee's Final Mandate on the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Bill [B42D-2012] as adopted by the Portfolio Committee on 04 October 2013.

#### 2. PROCESS FOLLOWED

- 2.1. The Speaker of the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature, on receipt, referred the *Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Bill* [B42B-2012] to the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism on 12 August 2013.
- 2.2. On 21 August 2013, the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism received a briefing on the Bill from the National Department of Trade & Industry and NCOP Permanent delegate Hon Sinclair.
- 2.3. The Portfolio Committee resolved at the meeting of 21 August 2013 to hold public hearings on the referred Bill, in four regions Pixley Ka Seme, John Taolo Gaetswewe, ZF Mqcawu and Namakwa Region, to solicit the views of communities and stakeholders with regard to the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Bill [B42B-2012]

Four (4) public hearings were concurrently held on 23 August 2013 as per Committee resolution and both written and oral submissions were called for. The public engaged with the Members of the Provincial Legislature in respect of the Bill.

On 10 September 2013, the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism deliberated and considered the Negotiating Mandate of Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Bill [B42B-2012]

#### 3. PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE POSITION AT THE NEGOTIATING STAGE

The Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism met on the 10 September 2013 to supports the Bill.

The House conferred on the Permanent Delegates the authority to participate in negotiations and to raise the concerns expressed.

# 4. COMMITTEE POSITION AFTER CONSIDERATION OF NEGOTIATING MANDATE BY THE NCOP SELECT COMMITTEE

The Portfolio Committee's Final Mandate indicated that the Northern Cape supports the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment BIII [B42D-2012]

#### 5. FINAL VOTING MANDATE

In terms of Section 65 of the Constitution, the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism recommends that the House confer authority on the Head of its Delegation to the NCOP to vote in <u>support</u> of the *Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Bill* [B42D–2012]
