## SURVEYED STATE/TRUST ADMIN AREAS & SDFs



- At the start of the project in 2011, the Department envisaged to survey an estimated 3.5mil Hectares of un-surveyed State Land in the former Homelands
- These areas located in former Homeland sectors of the Provinces of Mpumalanga, Limpopo and Eastern Cape

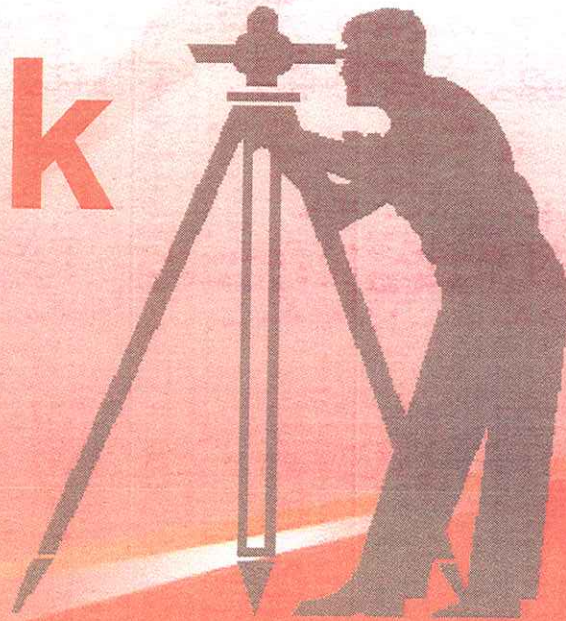
## SURVEYED AND APPROVED ADMINISTRATION AREAS



- During the 2012/13 financial year, 2 350 375Ha out of a targeted balance of 2.7mil Ha were surveyed.
- The figure also includes Quitrent Erven in the Eastern Cape and the Limpopo section of the Kruger National Park
- The overall achievement of the project was 95%
