The permanent delegate representing the Province of Mpumalanga in the National Council of Provinces, is hereby conferred with a mandate to vote in favour of the Bill, taking into account the observations of the Committee contained in the attached report.

The following proposed amendment is submitted to the Select Committee:

On page 3, clause 2(2)(b)

Delete the word "moral", to read as follows:

"the inquiry magistrate or the child justice court must consider the cognitive, **[moral,]** emotional, psychological and social development of the child.
