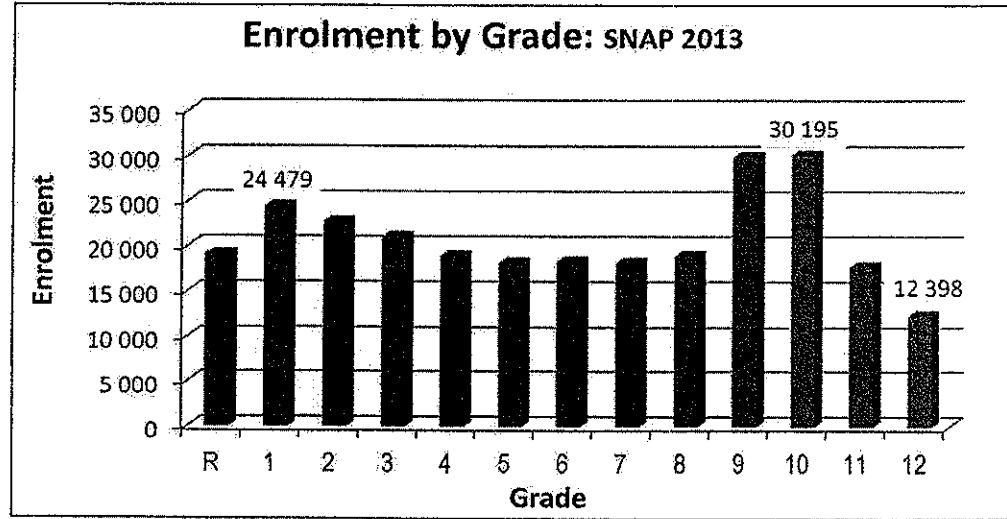

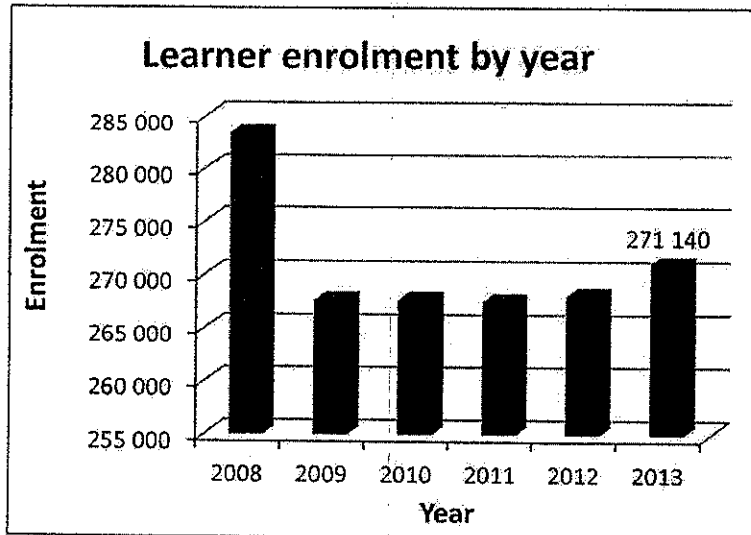

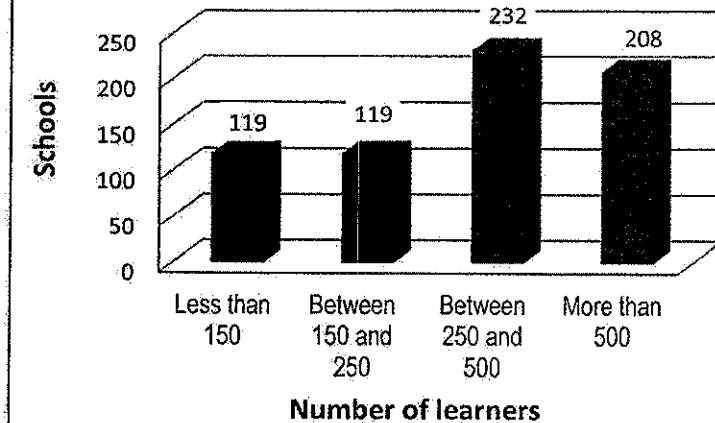

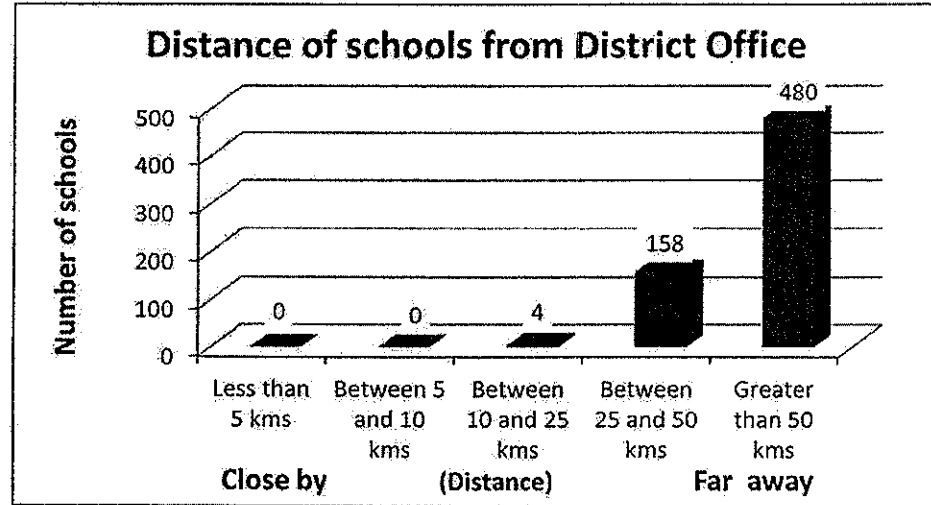


Number of Schools by Size (SNAP 2013 enrolment)



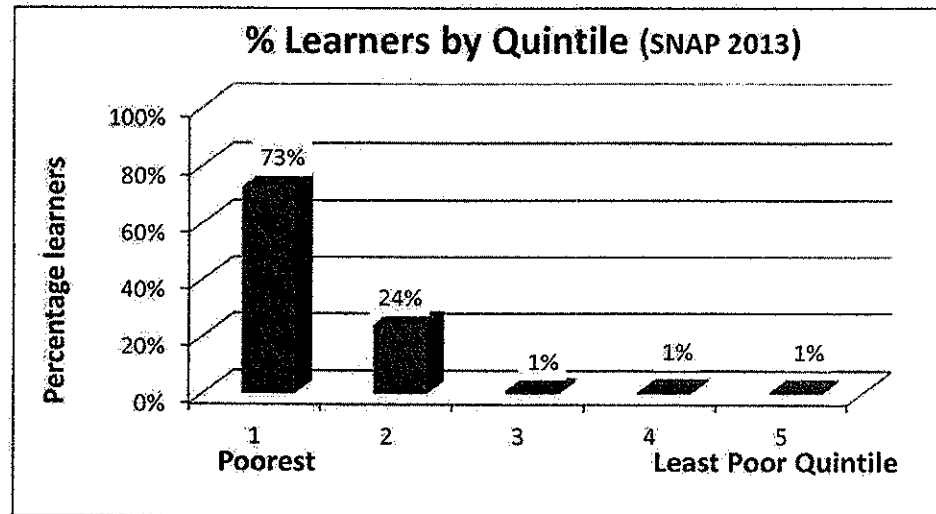

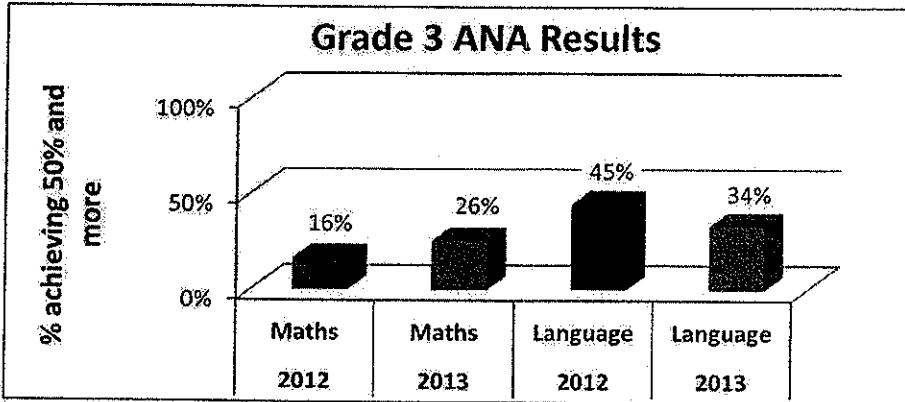

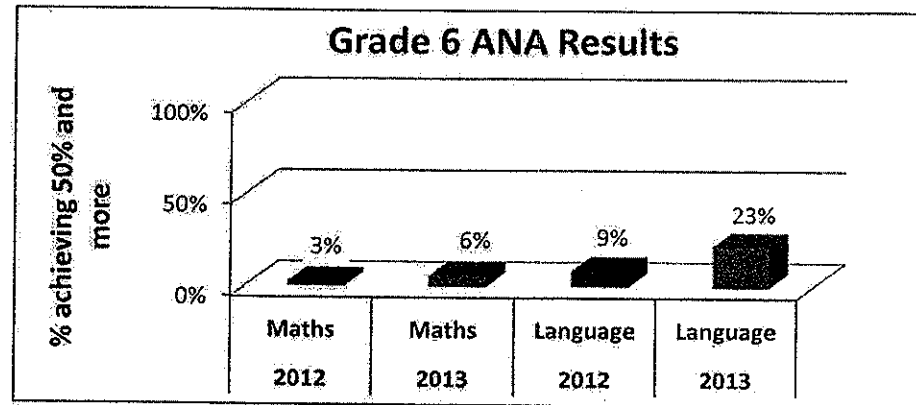

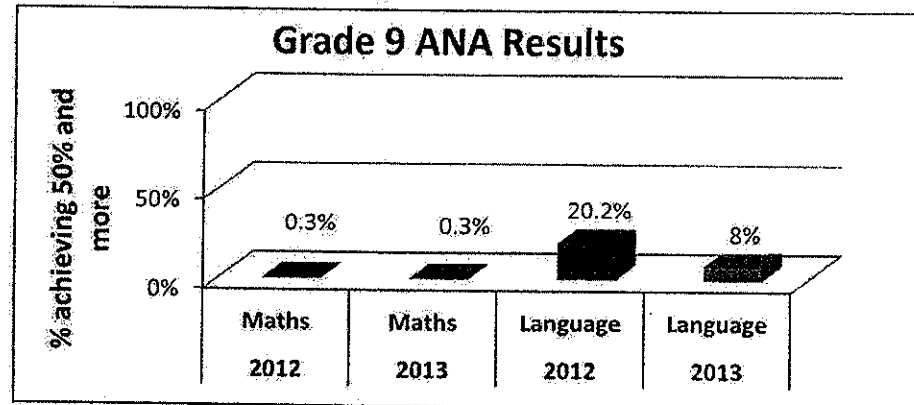

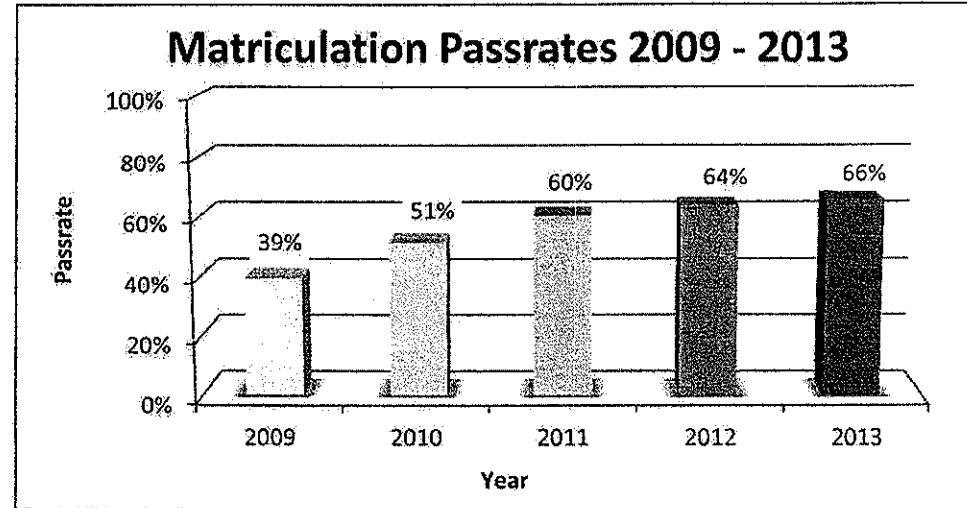

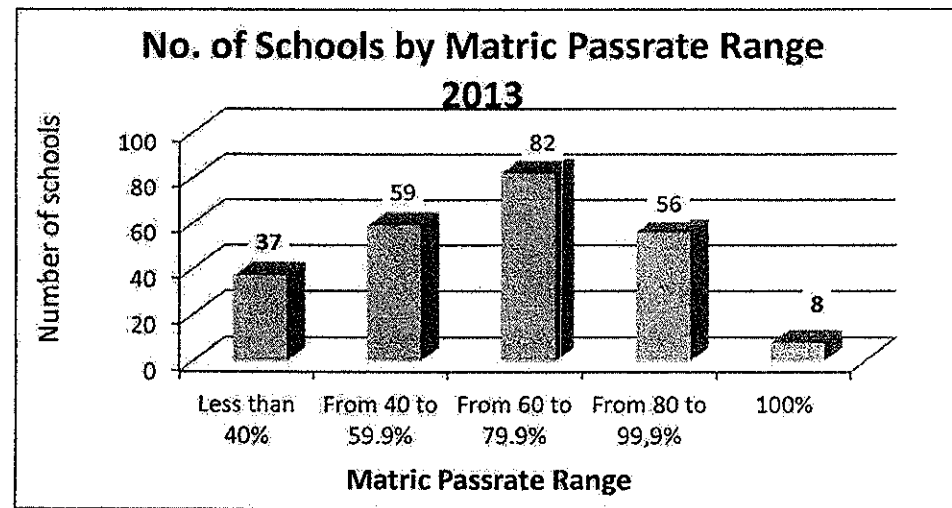

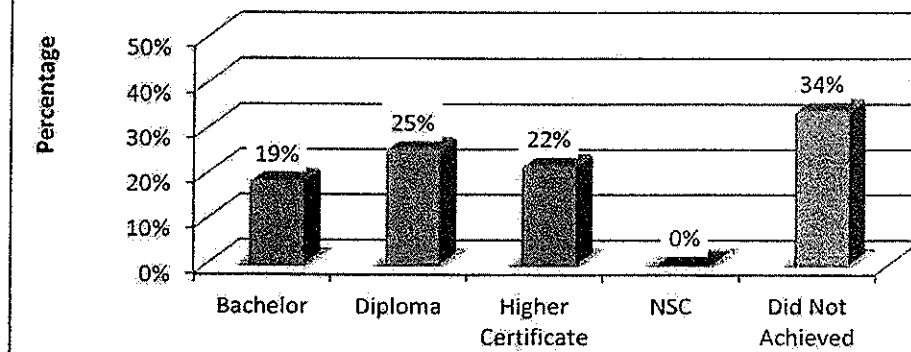

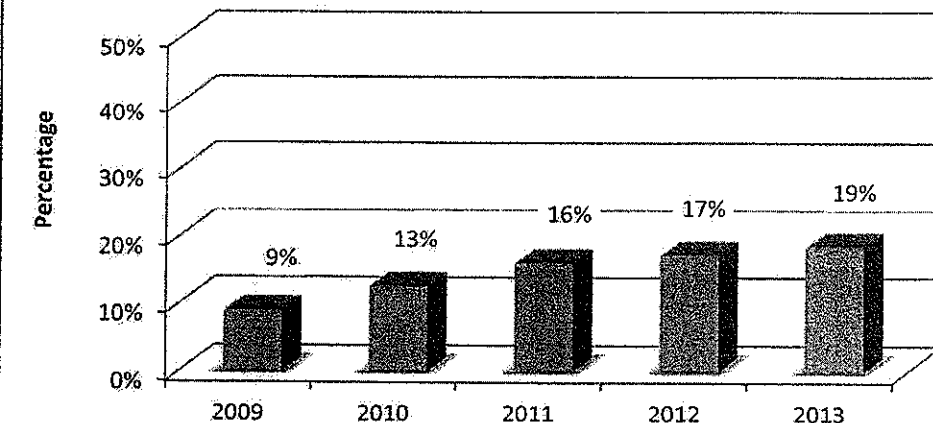

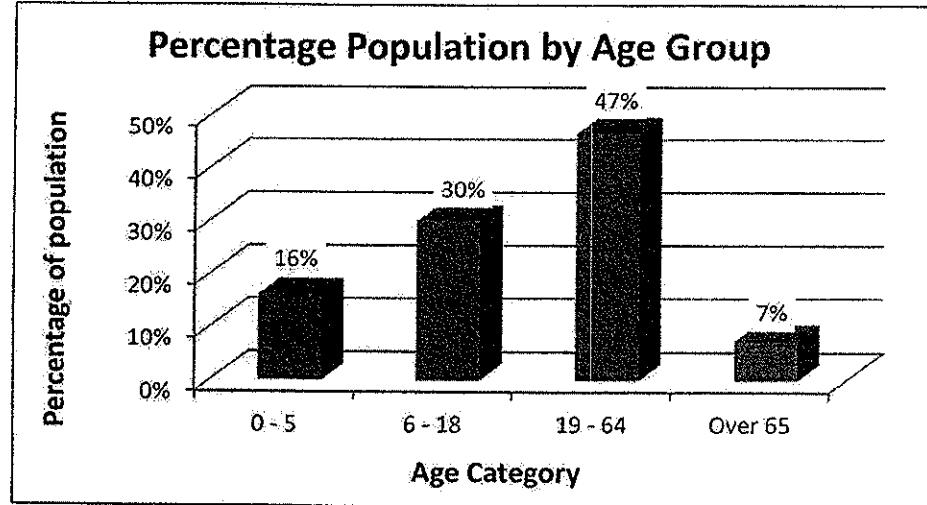

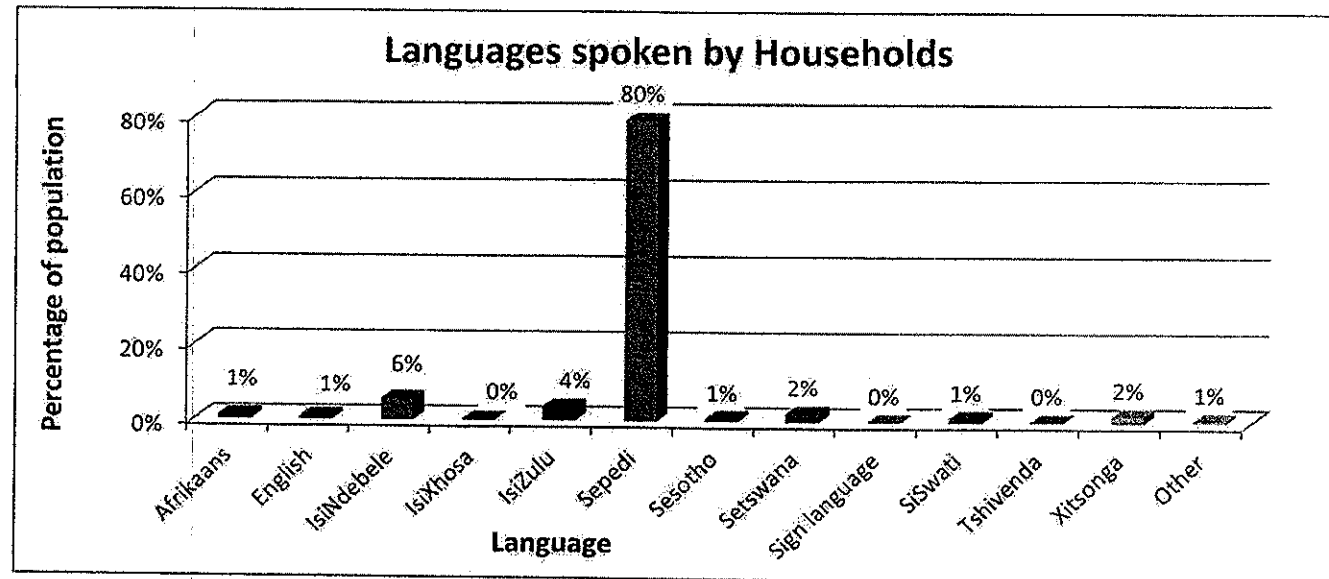

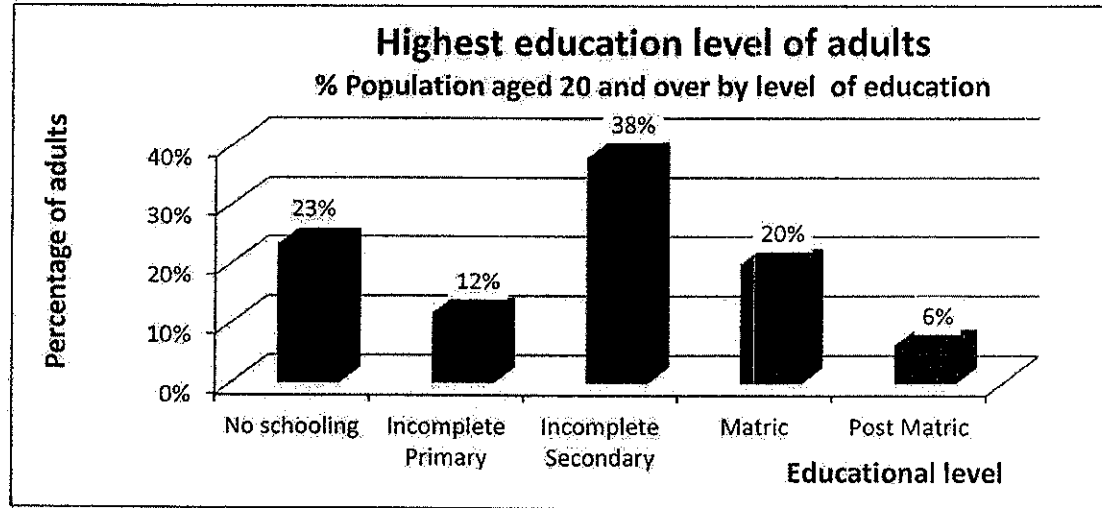

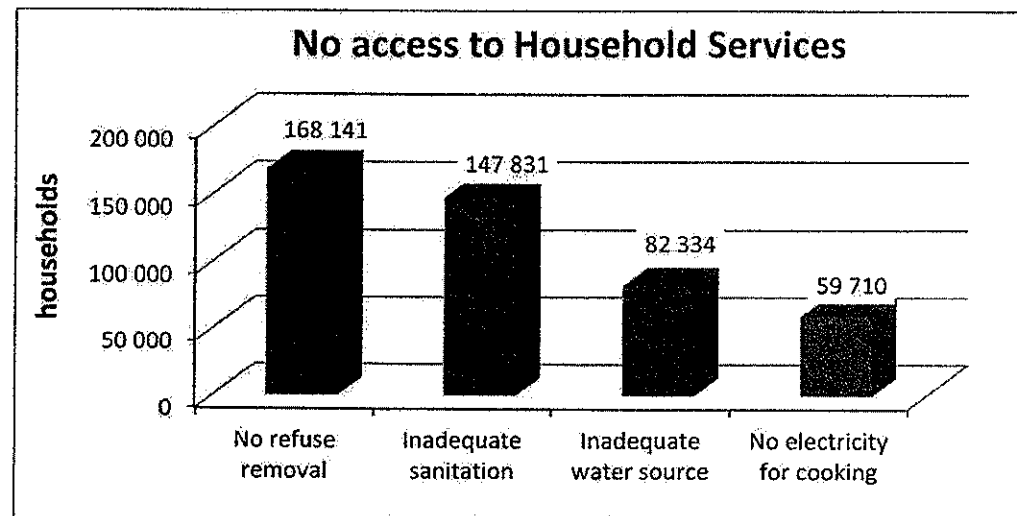

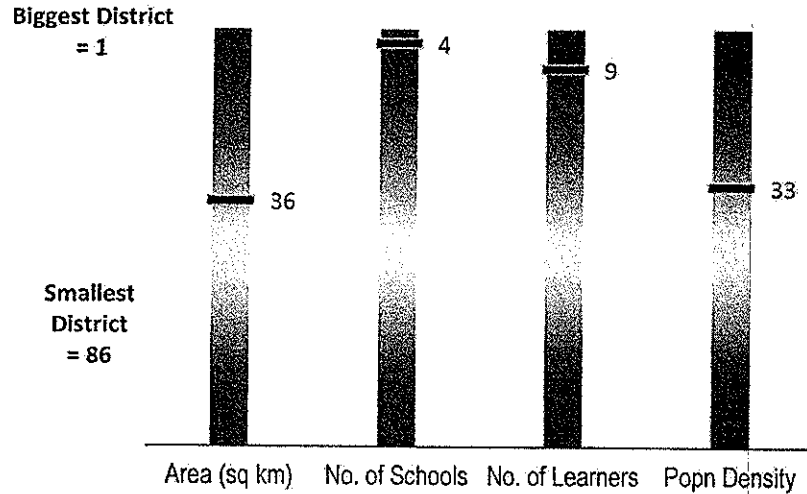


Inter-District Comparisons

How does this district compare to others in South Africa? A ranking of 1 denotes the best/highest district whereas 86 denotes worst/smallest

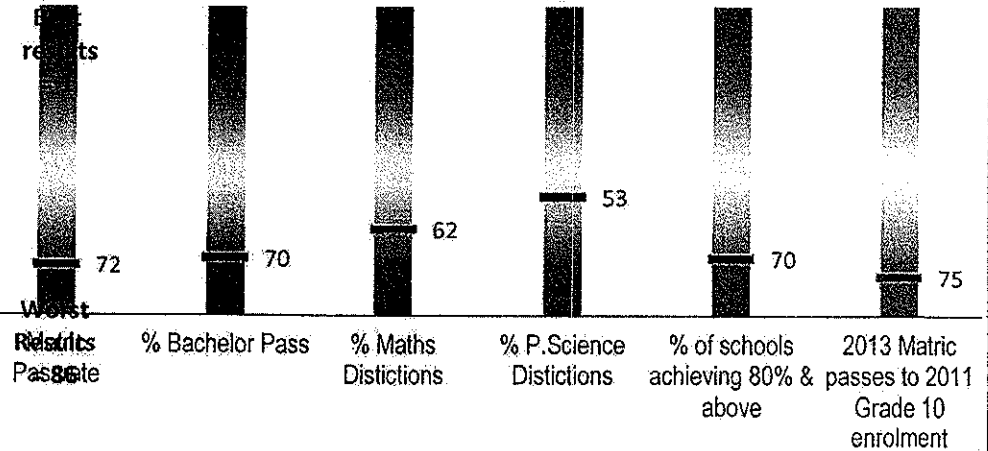
District Size

Relative to other districts - SNAP and GIS data



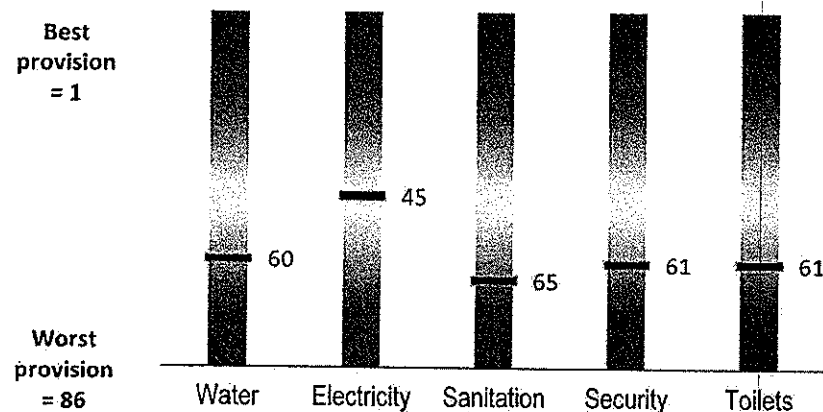
