

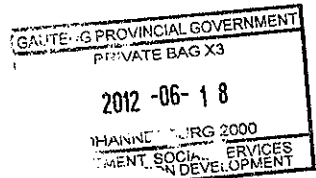

**COMPLAINT AGAINST MAGISTRATE MOLETZANE – DIVORCE COURT**

Your letter dated 27 August 2009 refers.

The complaint against the abovementioned presiding officer was investigated.

No indication could be found that the Magistrate presiding in the particular matter acted outside the scope of her judicial capacity. Accordingly the Magistrates Commission has no authority to interfere with the judgement given by the magistrate.

In terms of Chapter 8 of the Constitution, the judicial authority of the Republic is vested in the courts and that the courts are independent and subject only to the Constitution and the law. No person or organ of state may interfere with the functioning of the courts.

If you are of the view that the particular presiding officer misdirected him/herself in the process you are at liberty to take the matter on appeal/review to the relevant High Court. In this regard it is advised that you approach an attorney of your choice, who with all the relevant facts at his/her disposal will be in the best position to advise and/or assist you.

We regret to inform you that the Commission cannot take this matter any further and have closed its file in this regard.

**REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO RECORD OF PUBLIC BODY IN TERMS OF SECTION  
18(1) OF THE PROMOTION OF ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT, NO. 2 OF 2000:  
YOURSELF**

Your request for access to documentation of a Public Body dated 8 April 2010 as well as various conversations in this regard refer.

We approached the Ethics Division of the Magistrates Commission which initially dealt with your complaint to provide us with copies of the documents as were requested by you. It was established however that your complaint was submitted in the normal manner to the presiding magistrate for comments. Upon receipt of her comments the matter served before the Ethics Committee and it was resolved that no indication could be found that the Magistrate acted outside the scope of her judicial capacity and, furthermore, that the Commission has no authority to interfere with judgements given by judicial officers. You were informed accordingly in writing on 22 February 2010. A copy of the Commission's letter is attached for your ease of reference.

It should thus be clear that no preliminary investigation was deemed necessary and therefore no report was compiled regarding this matter. The decision was taken based on the information contained in the abovementioned documents.

It was in the circumstances not possible to provide you with the documents as per your written request since no such report was ever compiled. In an effort to assist you were invited to visit our offices and to personally go through the relevant file to identify documents which you would require copies of. When you visited our office on 13 October 2010 Mr Meijer was not available to provide us with the file. You furthermore demanded that you would rather again visit our office personally and that we should not send any documents to your postal address.

It is confirmed that we today handed copies of all documents as identified by you from the relevant office file to you personally.

Thank you for your fax dated the 21st instant and received on the 24th instant.

It seems that the matter has been resolved in all aspects but one, this being the issue of which firm of attorneys should attend to the transfer of the 50% share of the fixed property.

The writer would not have ad an objection to the attorneys appointed by your client attending to the transfer, under the writer's supervision but Messrs. Schickering, Bowen & Hesselink indeed do have an objection to your client's appointed attorneys attending to the transfer.

In the circumstances, especially having regard to the fact that the underlying motivation for the appointment of the said attorneys is that they will not be charging your client, kindly would you obtain confirmation from Miss. Leryal of the firm Ramathwala Leryal Inc, whether their firm would be willing to perform all the work that needs to be done in order to transfer the half share in the fixed property, on the basis that the writer would be appointed as the conveyancer in terms of the agreement of sale, but the writer would allow Messrs. Ramathwala Leryal Inc. to do all the work incidental to the transfer, subject to the writer's instructions and supervision.

In such a case the writer will not charge your client any fee and will not charge the joint estate any fee that would otherwise have been charged in the ordinary cause of such a transfer.

A copy of this letter has been forwarded to Messrs. Schickering, Bowen & Hesselink.

We invite you to submit a list of issues which your client requests the writer to investigate, in terms of paragraph 8 of your letter under reply, in so far as there might be particular issues that your client requires to be investigated.
