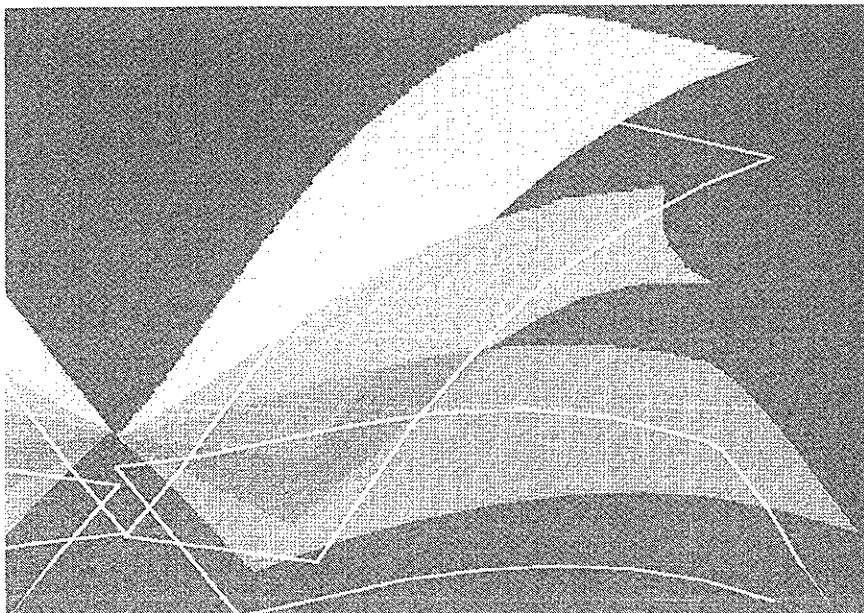

General Information

• **Intention of the Code**

To ensure that South Africa's elected leaders maintain the highest standards of propriety to ensure that their integrity and that of the political institutions that they serve are beyond questions.

• **Confidentiality**

All information in the confidential section of the Register will be kept in strict confidence. Only the Registrar and his/her staff and Committee on Members Interests, who are sworn to secrecy, have access to this information.

• **General**

Date of information or disclosures in this form must reflect the interest on the date of disclosure, including all gifts and hospitality received in the disclosure period. Where insufficient space is provided, please provide details on a separate sheet of paper. Members are advised to fully complete the disclosure form to ensure that the form reflects all the member's interests on the date of disclosure.

Information Sheet

NOTE 1

Shares and Financial Interests

A private company consists of any two persons associated for any lawful purpose and must be registered in terms of Chapter IV of the Companies Act. Please note that one person may also for a lawful purpose form a private company in terms of the same Act.

A public company is registered in terms of the requirements of Chapter IV of the Companies Act and must consist of seven members or more.

A corporate body recognized by law consists of any two persons associated for any lawful purpose and must also be registered in terms of Part III of the Close Corporation Act.

A financial interest is any formal or informal investment that a member holds for the purposes of deriving a return.

Shares and Financial Interests of Immediate Family must be disclosed in the confidential section.

Note 2

Remunerated Employment outside Parliament

All employment must be sanctioned by the Member's political party.

Remuneration means the receipts of benefits in cash or kind.

The employment must not be incompatible with the Members function as an elected representative. In terms of 47(1) (a) of the Constitution a member may not be appointed or be in service by the state unless that employment has been declared compatible with those functions by national legislation.

Member's political party to provide relevant details of such employment to the Registrar within 30 days.

Details of Remuneration must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 3

Directorships and Partnerships

All directorship/ partnership must be disclosed, including those directorships in dormant companies.

Members are advised to personally ensure that the information contained in the CIPC records are correct.

Directorship: includes any position occupying the position of director or alternate director, by whatever the name the position is designated.

Partnership: is a legal relationship arising out of a contract between two or more persons with the object making and sharing profits.

Remuneration received from Directorships and partnerships must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Directorships and partnerships of immediate family must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 4

Consultancies/ Retainerships

Members must disclose any interest in any consulting firm or company that provides advice or professional services.

Note 5

Sponsorships

All sponsorships or assistance directly to a member from non-party sources must be disclosed.

Value of Sponsorship must be disclosed in confidential section of the Register.

Details of sponsorship obtained by immediate family must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 6

Gifts and Hospitality

Specify all gifts with a value and source in excess of R1500 or gifts from a single source which cumulatively exceeds the value R1500 in any calendar year.

Any hospitality intended as a gift in kind must be disclosed. All personal gifts within the family and hospitality of a specifically traditional or cultural nature need not be disclosed.

Member may not accept any gift which causes him/her a conflict of interests

Note 7

Benefits

Members must disclose any material advantage that he/she receives from any source.

For example any special discounts which are not available to the general public and all interest free loans.

Value of benefits must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Benefits received by a Members immediate family to be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 8

Travel

Visits paid for entirely by the Member, business visits unrelated to the Members role as a public representative or formal visits paid for by the Members political party or the government are excluded from registration.

Where the nature of a visit requires confidentiality, it should be registered in the confidential section.

Travel paid for immediate family by outside sources must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 9

Land and Property

All Land and Property must be disclosed, details of residential property may be disclosed in the confidential section.

Note 10

Pensions

Members are required to disclose only the pensions that they are currently receiving.

Members are not required to disclose contributions to pension funds.

Note 11

Public Contracts

Members are prohibited from tendering for public contracts while in office, however should they be awarded contracts prior to their appointment as Members they are required to disclose all details public contracts which they hold at the time of taking of office, the information must include the period of the contract, value and the name of the state entity which awarded the contract. Members may not renew such contract while they are in office.

A Member's immediate family or business partner may not receive any contract or benefit arising out of any influence exercised by the Member.

Public contracts awarded to immediate family must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 12

Trusts

Members are required to disclose details of all trusts in which they are trustees or beneficiaries. Where they receive any benefits the details of the benefits must be disclosed.

Trusts information related to immediate family must be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

Note 13

Encumbrances

Members are required to disclose details of all long term loans; and registered mortgage bonds.

Encumbrances may be disclosed in the confidential section of the Register.

FURTHER PROHIBITIONS

Finance Management of Parliament Act Section 46

No contract to provide goods or services to Parliament may be awarded to:-

- (a) a Member of Parliament or a Member of the Cabinet;
- (b) a Member of a Provincial Legislature or a Member of a Provincial, Executive Council
- (c) a Municipal councillor;
- (d) a person in the employ of the State whose

participation in bidding for the contract may result in a conflict of interest; or
(e) any entity in which a person mentioned in

paragraphs (a) to (d) is a Director or has a controlling or other substantial interest.

PART B:

CONFIDENTIAL SECTION

Information disclosed in regard to immediate family is kept in the confidential part of the Register, unless a member at his own discretion decides otherwise.

Interests of Immediate Family: this code applies to any spouse, permanent companion or dependents of any Member to whom this code applies, to the extent that the Member is aware or entitled to disclose any registrable interest held by such person.
