



PROPOSED PROGRAMME: PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE TRADITIONAL AND KHOI-SAN LEADERSHIP BILL, 2015

INTRODUCTION

The Traditional and Khoi-San Leadership Bill, 2015 as introduced in the National Assembly as a section 76 Bill was referred to the Portfolio Committee on Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs for finalization. The Committee is expected to conduct public hearings in all the nine provinces.

It is proposed that the Committee be divided into two main groups. Group 1 will conduct public hearings in the following Provinces: Mpumalanga, Limpopo, North West, Gauteng and the Free State. Group 2 will focus on the Provinces of the Eastern Cape and Kwazulu Natal. It is proposed that the entire Committee conduct the public hearings in Northern Cape and Western Cape (Khoi and San Communities)
