We may not know whether the families of the officials who were constituting the bid evaluation committee were involved in the tender because we do not know who their family members are.</p> <p>(aa), (bb) and (cc) all refer to the NSNP contract that ran for the financial years 2011-2012, 2012-13, and 2013-14.</p> <p>From April 2014 to March 2015 the main suppliers who were supplying the same SMME's that were supplying from 2011-14 March were supplying schools directly to schools.</p>	Limpopo
