




BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE MINE



- All underground workers were rescued through the ventilation shaft which served a second escape route

- The Honourable Minister of Mineral Resources Mr M Zwane visited the Lily Gold Mine on the same day.






COLLAPSED AREA AT THE MINE



- A Mines Rescue Drill rig has arrived at the mine on Thursday the 18th February 2016 afternoon
- The rig is similar to the drill used in the Chilean rescue operation in 2010.
- This machine is capable of drilling a 600mm diameter hole, which will reach 5 level at depth of about 80 metres.
- Drilling commenced on Saturday 20th February 2016. It is envisaged drilling will take two to three Weeks






RESCUE DRILL RIG








