










## PILLAR ONE: ESTABLISHMENT OF STRUCTURES



- Jukskei is the only code that recognized by SASCOC of the nine IG Codes
- The other eight codes have been operating without any formal structures
- All nine Provinces have completed the process of electing Provincial Structures for each code
- At the last meeting with the Provinces it was recommended that Interim Committees be formed for each of the eight












### PILLAR ONE: INTERIM NATIONAL COMMITTEES

- The Interim National Committees would be constituted by representatives from each Provincial Code Structure
- There tasks:
  - Prepare the Constitutions for each Code
  - Prepare all documentation required for the administration of the code
  - Serve as Steering Committee to ensure the election of National Code Structure

Would be dissolved when the National Association leadership is elected



### PILLAR ONE: INTERIM NATIONAL COMMITTEES

- Provinces to assist with transportation of Interim Committee Members from the provinces to the National Meetings
- SRSA to be responsible for logistics (venue, meals, refreshments and accommodation if necessary)

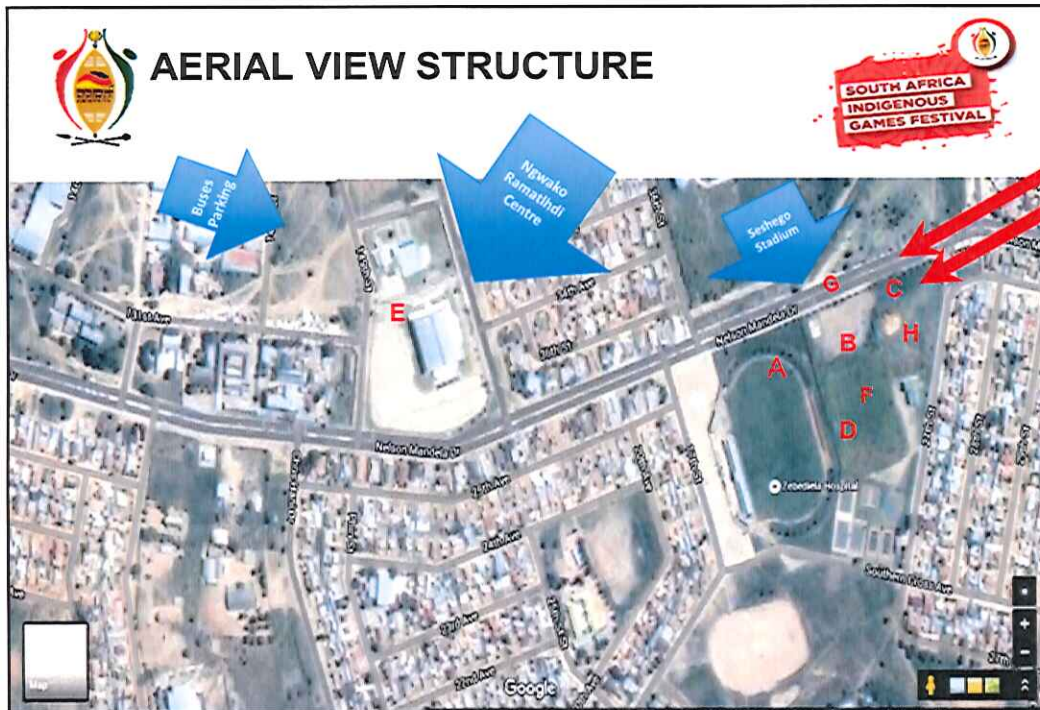

- Provinces requested to identify new Technical Officials who were not part of the 2015 IG Festival in Polokwane – Provincial Coordinators confirmed that this has been done
  - Provinces to transport Technical Officials from their Provinces to Polokwane and back
  - SRSA to transport Technical Officials in Polokwane for the duration of the Games
  - Provinces to ensure that each Technical Official sign a Code of Conduct before end of August 2016

## PILLAR TWO: TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

- At the last National Stakeholders meeting Provinces and Code Representatives recommended that there be no allowance or form of remuneration for Technical Officials
- This is to be articulated in the Code of Conduct to be signed by the Technical Officials

## PILLAR TWO: RULES GOVERNING THE GAMES

- To eliminate protests and disputes the rules are being streamlined and clearly articulated were there were ambiguities
- A single document “Indigenous Games General and Code Specific Rules” is being finalized.
- The content “existing rules” would not change for 2016. Rules would be amended for 2017 and future Games
