- ✓ The venue must be camp site (out door venture accessible by people with disability );
- ✓ Accommodate about 300 participants in the roundtable's and chairs
- ✓ Enough space for out door activities;
- ✓ It must provide catering for participants and officials (recent health certificate must be produced and submitted to SRSA);
- ✓ Property liability cover must be activated
- ✓ Private security at the gates and inside;
- ✓ Control room for safety and security meetings;
- ✓ Ablution facilities should also cater for disabilities;
- ✓ Working showers with both cold and hot water;
- ✓ In house waste management;
- ✓ Sufficient water points;
- ✓ Enough lighting; and additional spot light will be installed around the venue
- ✓ Motor vehicles parking and parking for emergency service vehicles;
- ✓ Medical room, Media room, Meeting room and Holding room

**National Youth Camp Outreach Service Day**

What is the Purpose of the National Youth Camp Outreach Youth Service Day?

In the context of the National Youth Camp the purpose of the Outreach Youth Service Program is:

- To inculcate in young people an understanding of their important role in South Africa's development, to assist them to participate constructively in community reintegration and nation building and to develop pro-social behaviour.
- To enable young people to develop the skills, knowledge and ability necessary for them to make the transition to healthy independent adulthood.
- To provide a vehicle through which South Africa can deliver its development objectives, through the deployment of young people.
- To promote a common sense of nationhood
- Raise the profile of the SRS in the affected communities

## Safety and Security

- Public liability
- ✓ Public liability must be procured before the event takes place
- ✓ Public liability must be submitted to SRSA before the 10 September 2016
- Accreditation
- ✓ All people must be accredited including the quest
- ✓ Accreditation will be done on registration on arrival
- ✓ All accreditation will have photos
- Security
- ✓ Security must be beef up at the camp
- ✓ Additional security must be appointed
- ✓ The security must be accredited and vetted

## Transport

- ✓ The Province must procure transport for the participants
- ✓ The transport plan must be submitted to SRSA before 10 September 2016
- ✓ Transport liability must be submitted to SRSA before the 20 September 2016
- ✓ Roadworthy certificates and PDP copies must be attached to transport liability
