## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

(Negotiating mandate stage) Report of the Standing Committee on Community Development on the Children's Second Amendment Bill [B 14B-2015] (NCOP), dated 15 November 2016, as follows:

The Standing Committee on Community Development, having considered the subject of the *Children's Second Amendment Bill [B* 14B-2015] (NCOP), referred to it in terms of Standing Rule 220, confers on the Western Cape's delegation in the NCOP the authority to support the Bill with the following amendments and a concern:

## Clause 1

- 1. On page 2, in line 13, after the Social Services Professions Act, 1978 (Act No. 110 of 1078) to insert "and accredited in terms of the Children's Act, (No. 38 of 2005)".
- 2. On page 2, in line 18, to delete (b) and substitute with (c) and on page 3, in line 22, to delete (c) and substitute with (d).

## Clause 5

3. On page 5, in Clause 5(b), the Committee wishes to raise a concern that this section may be understood to imply that children who are not 18 years old and not in Grade 12, will not be able to apply for alternative care.
