EMPLOYMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL DEFENCE FORCE IN CO-OPERATION WITH THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE.

This serves to inform the National Assembly that, I have authorised the employment of Four Hundred and Forty One (441) members of the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) for service in co-operation with members of the South African Police Service (SAPS) during the opening of Parliament in Cape Town.

Members of the SANDF employed will be assisting the SAPS to maintain law and order during the opening of Parliament.


This employment is authorised in accordance with the provisions of section 201(2)(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996.

The employment is for the period of 05 February to 10 February 2017.

The total expenditure expected to be incurred for the employment is R 204 153.60
