**REQUEST FOR UPGRADING OF PRECAST WALL BY ELECTRIC FENCE: HOUSES OF  
THE NATIONAL HEAD AND THE DEPUTY NATIONAL HEAD: PROMAT  
BUILDING.SILVERTON: DIRECTORATE FOR PRIORITY CRIME INVESTIGATION.**

1. This office hereby request for the upgrading of the precast wall by the electric fence surrounding the houses of the National Head and the Deputy National Head for Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation as a matter of urgency.

**Background:**

- 1.1 On 2016-05-26 a stakeholders meeting to discuss the security of our National Head and Deputy was held at DPCI Promat building and DPW was amongst the role players. After the meeting, a site visit was conducted to the houses and a need to upgrade the fence was established. The houses on the premises are occupied by the National Head and the Deputy National Head of the DPCI. These executives are mandated to investigate serious corruption, serious organized crime and serious commercial crimes in South Africa and they are a treat to high profile criminals.
- 1.2 The electric fence which surrounded Promat building has been cut threw on numerous occasions and as a result, expensive equipment's and copper wires were stolen from the house. As for now, because of this crime trend this office was compelled to replace copper wire by galvanized pipes to avoid further damage and theft. Most recently, cases for theft of copper pipes were opened for investigation as per Silverton CAS 67/04/2016, Silverton CAS 789/02/2015 and Silverton CAS 170/03/2015.

**REQUEST FOR UPGRADING OF PRECAST WALL BY ELECTRIC FENCE: HOUSES OF THE NATIONAL HEAD AND THE DEPUTY NATIONAL HEAD: PROMAT BUILDING. SILVERTON: DIRECTORATE FOR PRIORITY CRIME INVESTIGATION.**

- 1.3 The building is no longer safe to our members if criminals are breaking and entering in this way and took what they want without proper security measures put in place, soothing urgent has to be done as the lives of our Heads are in danger.
- 1.4 Access to the building was gained throw different cuttings to the electric fence and at strategic places such as the houses of the National Head and the Deputy National Head. The precast wall was also tempered with and broken to gain access to the houses.
- 1.5 The request to repair the damaged electric fence has been reported to Department of Public Works on numerous occasions and they indicated that the installation of the electric fence will result in projects that can be time delaying as they take long.
- 1.6 The following references have bearing on this matter i.e. PRE106725 and PRE126507.
- 1.7 SAPS Facility Management office will bear the costs to accommodate a project that has to be done by DPW.

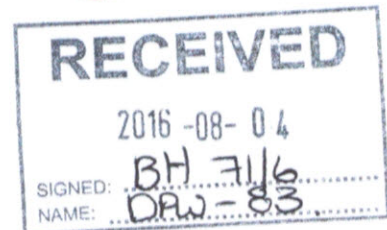

The request to repair the damaged electric fence at the Promat Building was reported to your Department on numerous occasions.


