#### **ABOUT IRBA**

- IRBA 's strategic focus is to <u>protect</u> the <u>financial interest</u> of the <u>public</u> by ensuring that only suitably qualified individuals are admitted to the auditing profession and that <u>registered auditors</u> deliver <u>services of the highest quality</u> and adhere to the <u>highest ethical standards</u>.
- IRBA conducts investigations to determine compliance by registered auditors with the Code of Professional Conduct for Registered auditors and International Auditing Standards.



#### **ABOUT IRBA**

- The IRBA has, at any point in time, approximately 150 open investigations and due to budget constraints, only 5 investigators.
- The Steinhoff investigation has been prioritised.



# STEINHOFF INVESTIGATION UPDATE

- Letter of investigation was sent by IRBA to Deloitte in December 2017 regarding possible allegations of improper conduct.
- IRBA received a detailed response to initial letter from Deloitte on 29 January 2018 (covering 3 years of audits-2014 to 2016).
- IRBA requested and received additional information from Deloitte covering 2 further years and other matters.



# STEINHOFF INVESTIGATION UPDATE

- IRBA is currently reviewing information received with the highest priority.
- Cooperation from the audit firm has been satisfactory.
- It is however important to note that the IRBA still requires the restated financial statements once issued.
- As this is a complex investigation involving multiple entities and requiring cross-jurisdictional engagements within the various countries' laws, it is not currently possible to reliably estimate the complete scope and therefore timeframes for completion.
