Guided by Constitutional Mandate

SECTION 78 Establishment of and principles governing Commissioner for Children

- The Commissioner must assist the Western Cape Government in protecting and promoting the interests of children in the Western Cape, in particular as regards —
- (a) health services;
- (b) education;
- (c) welfare services;
- (d) recreation and amenities; and
- (e) sport.

SECTION 80 Appointment and removal





Guided by Constitutional Mandate

SECTION 79
Powers and duties

- The Commissioner has the power as regulated in provincial advise and report on, matters pertaining to children. legislation to monitor, investigate, research, educate, lobby,
- The Commissioner—
- (a) must report annually to the Provincial Parliament on the measures the interests of children in the Western Cape; and taken by the Western Cape government to protect and promote
- (b) may report to the Provincial Parliament at any other time.


