In the above matter we, the ex TRTC Mthatha Depot employees on the advice of our Legal Representative, Sangoni and Associates, decided to approach you, Madam, for assistance in trying to recover monies that were due to us when the Corporation closed down.

In 1995, a resolution was taken by the Unions together with the Hon. MEC Marasha to close the bus service for intergration and adjustment of salaries. In 1996, Corporation was closed with a promise that the company will reopen in March 1997. When the bus company did not open in 1997 and years later, we were surprised.

PREMIER OF THE EASTERN CAPE**

In the above matter we, the ex TRTC Mthatha Depo employees decided to approach you Sir for assistance in trying to recover moneys that were due to us when the Corporation closed down.

In April 1995 the bus service was closed by then MEC Mandisa Marasha and which action took us by surprise because we were never consulted but heard from the Radio. We had our Unions and Shopstewards but if there is anything they knew, they never properly advised or informed us.

We tried to follow all channels trying to recover the monies but to no avail. All Premiers starting from the Honourable Mr M. Stofile to the current Premier Ms N Kiviet know about our predicament.

At some stage this matter went before court under case no. 203/2000. During the course of the proceedings depositions separated because of the length of time it took to finalise we approached the office of the Public Prosecutor for assistance. It is then that we were advised that same judgment was given in all these cases and the matter was closed.

**RE- APPEAL FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE BY FORMER EMPLOYEES OF
TRANSKEI ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATION**

- 1) In April 1995 the above mentioned bus service was closed by the former Minister of transport MEC Mandisa Marasha. The shocking announcement was heard by all of us from the radio after working hours when we all at home.
- 2) This was a sad moment as there was never a rumour that such a step could ever be taken. We have exhausted all the avenues we think we should have taken. The three premiers of the Eastern Cape Government Mr. M. Stofile, Mrs. N. Balindile and Miss N. Keviet know about this matter and no attempt has ever been taken by them to solve it.
- 3) Different opinions have emerged from some of our members and in the public domain, such as Toyi-toyi, sit in and media. Neither of these opinions have been entertained by us because we have a firm belief and conviction that the Government is a composition of human beings created in the image of God and as such has a feeling of humanity and generosity.
- 4) We are dealing with people who are hell -bent in destroying this part of the Eastern Cape because we read in news papers, sometime that when their transport was in financial constraints the government stepped in and rescued them.

"Effect of sequestration on contract of service

38. (1) The contracts of service of employees whose employer has been sequestered are suspended with effect from the date of the granting of a sequestration order.
- (2) Without limiting subsection (1), during the period of suspension of a contract of service referred to in subsection (1)-
- (a) an employee whose contract is suspended is not required to render services in terms of the contract and is not entitled to any remuneration in terms of the contract; and
 - (b) no employment benefit accrues to an employee in terms of the contract of service which is suspended.
- (3) An employee whose contract of service is suspended is entitled to unemployment benefits in terms of section 35 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1966 (Act No. 30 of 1966), from the date of such suspension, subject to the provisions of that Act."

I regret that I can take this matter no further.
