BRIEF OUTLINE OF THE PUBLIC HEARINGS - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Constitutional Review Committee (the Committee) was instructed by the National Assembly (NA) and the National Council of Provinces (NCOP) to 'review section 25 of the Constitution and other clauses where necessary, to make it possible for the state to expropriate land, in the public interest without compensation, and propose the necessary constitutional amendments where necessary. In doing so, the Committee is expected to engage in a public participation process in order to get the views of all stakeholders about the necessity of, and mechanisms for expropriating land without compensation.

- > The outreach program has been moved from the end of May to the end of June in order to allow members of the NCOP to complete their Budget approval processes.
- > The committee will hold four (4) hearings in KZN; Eastern Cape; Limpopo; Western Cape & Northern Cape
- > The Committee will hold three (3) hearings in Gauteng; Mpumalanga: Free State & North West
- > In all instances there will be at least one hearing over a weekend day.
- > There will be a need to request a deadline extension from 31 August to 11 September 2018.
