
The table below indicates that the department planned to achieve 23 targets in Q3. However, **9** targets were achieved, **6** were partially achieved and **8** targets were not achieved.




## Q3 YEAR-ON-YEAR COMPARISON


## PERFORMANCE COMPARISONS PER PROGRAMME
