REPORT OF THE PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE ON COOPERATIVE GOVERNANCE, HUMAN SETTLEMENT AND TRADITIONAL AFFAIRS ON TRADITIONAL LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE FRAMEWORK AMENDMENT BILL, 2017[B8B-2017]

1. INTRODUCTION

The Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Amendment Bill, 2017[B8B-2017] was introduced in the august House from the National Council of Provinces (NCOP) and the Bill was subsequently referred to the Portfolio Committee on Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs for consideration and inputs.

2. OBJECTS OF THE BILL

To amend the Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Act, 2003, so as to make provision for extended timeframes within which kingship or queenship councils and traditional councils must be established; to provide for extended timeframes within which community authorities have to be disestablished; to align the term of office of tribal authorities, traditional councils and kingship or queenship councils with the term of the National House of Traditional Leaders; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

3. CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL

The committee held a meeting with the Permanent Delegates from the NCOP together with the officials from the Department of Traditional Affairs on 07 November 2017 to receive a detailed briefing on the principles and objects of the Bill. Subsequent to the meeting of 07 November 2017, the committee conducted public hearings in the district municipalities of the province and submitted negotiating mandate on the Bill.

Upon receipt of the minutes of the Select Committee on Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs, the committee met on 20 September 2018 and agreed with amendments made on the Bill.

4. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee recommends that the House confers a final mandate to the NCOP Delegates to vote in favour of the Bill.

5. CONCLUSION

I move that this report be adopted as the report of this august House.
