VOTE OF THE LEGISLATURE

The Portfolio Committee on Public Works, Infrastructure, Roads, Transport and Human Settlement, as design by the Free State Legislature:

Vote in favour of the Bill with the following amendments: -

1. That there should be uniformity and consistency on regulations by the Minister and the MEC's in different provinces.
2. That the powers given to taxi associations with regard to operating licensees need to change,
3. That the Department must take responsibility in issuing licensees.
4. Scholar transport should also be issued licenses to transport learners.
5. Any transport faring passengers illegally must be impounded.
6. Operators that are using routes that are not allocated to them must pay a fine to stop violence in the taxi ranks.

7. Taxi permits should be extended from 7 years to 15 years and or indefinitely.
8. The Bill is supported by the community of the Free State.
9. The report be adopted by the House.
