We refer to the above mentioned matter.

As a level 3 B-BBEE contributor, Huawei is further committed to the development of small, medium and micro-sized enterprises ("SMMEs") in South Africa. In this regard we have invested in the region of R10 000 000.00 (Ten Million Rand) in Enterprise and Supplier Development. The beneficiaries of this investment have received assistance from Huawei to enable them to be financially and operationally independent. Huawei has also invested in training these beneficiaries to ensure that they are equipped with the requisite knowledge and skills to be able to meet the project deliverables and to be able to compete in the market.

In the spirit of supporting SMMEs, Huawei committed at the last portfolio committee meeting to revisit the claim by Digiwire for unpaid invoices to the value of R818, 416.88.

After careful and thorough consideration of the claims made by Digiwire, we were unable to confirm the veracity of same. However even though we were / are under no legal or other obligation to do so a payment to the value of R440, 832.23 was made to Digiwire on 12 Oct 2018. A value of R377, 629.65, relating to an undisputed duplicated payment made by Huawei to Digiwire, was deducted from the claim of R818, 416.88.

The above payment was made by Huawei in full and final settlement of the dispute between the parties and without admitting any liability, fault, wrongdoing or actual indebtedness.

We also re-issued Work completion certificates for the sites where they have in fact completed the work as per their contractual obligations.

Our failure to deal with or address any specific allegation, claim or statement made by Digiwire or Me. Govender should not be deemed as an admission in any way or form and do our rights remain strictly reserved.
