I'm the Ward Councillor Moses Mangali of Ward 16 Breede Valley Municipality, 90% of my Ward is an Informal Settlement in my Ward stays old people disabled people and people without jobs. Where we are staying there is no facilities for water, electricity, roads or any toilets. People use plastic bags to help themselves. There is playing ground for children and our children walks 5km till 6km to school and the library and also old and disabled people they must walk 6km to get to the Clinic or 11 km to get to the Hospital. there is no mobile Police Station for them if there is problems that must be handled by the police. they also have to walk 7km to make use of this facility.

The 10% of Ward 16, is a Formal Settlement that is the Side where Power Construction suppose to build 652 RDP Houses that was approved in the year 2014, nothing happened yet, I just want to know what the holdup at our Municipality or our Provincial Offices is.

As a ANC Councillor at a DA Municipality we don't get any attention in our wards and people are blaming the Ward Councillor for failing them as there was promises made by the Municipality at the IDP meetings in 2015.

I really hope our National Chief Whip can intervene in our problem in the Breede Valley.
