




- Past expenditure for multiple years are utilised to perform an expenditure analysis and to project anticipated baseline expenditure in a financial year.

Total spending for Vote: 2020/21








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Comparison of monthly spending with previous financial years – (Cumulative)



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

Key spending trends for Vote per programme reasonably in line for this time of the financial year.



Programme 1: Administration

- Lower than linear spending mainly as salary increases were not paid as anticipated, COVID-19 lockdown regulations prevented movement of SAPS employees as well as procurements that could not be processed. Building industry was also closed and capital projects could not be executed.
- Programme 2: Visible Policing, Programme 3: Detective Services, Programme 4: Crime Intelligence and Programme 5: Protection and Security Services
 - Lower than linear spending mainly as salary increases were not paid as anticipated, COVID-19 lockdown regulations prevented movement of SAPS employees between provinces as well as procurements that could not be processed. Basically no capital procurements such as vehicles could be done.

Programme 2: Visible Policing

 Baseline reprioritisation towards COVID-19 expenditure was required from SAPS and additional funding of R3,7 billion, earmarked by National Treasury, was allocated in the Special Adjustments budget in support of SAPS' response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Allocation of such to Programme 2 was done in June 2020 and spending thereon also had an impact on the Programme.



 Compensation of Employees actual spending for period comprises 23,5% of allocated budget and is slightly lower than 25% linear benchmark.

Still to be paid

- Cost of living salary increases from 1 April 2020. (Currently in Labour Court) Alternatively, funding in budget will be suspended during the Adjustment Estimate Budget process;
- Pay progression with effective date of 1 July 2020

Overview of spending performance – Economic level (2)



Spending on Goods and Services comprises 21,7% of allocated budget:
Largely effected by COVID-19 lockdown regulations and movement restrictions;
Expenditure on COVID-19 project was R1,373 billion at 30 June 2020.
Integrated Criminal Justice Strategy spending was below linear benchmark;
Some Public Works invoices received up to June were much lower than anticipated – (Effected by municipalities and DPW lockdown)

•**Transfers and subsidies** slightly higher than the linear benchmark at 27,6% as a result of exit payments to early retirements of 31 March 2020.

Capped leave & in-year pro-rata leave payments

•Payments for **Capital Assets** comprises 4,9 % of allocated budget:

Buildings and Infrastructure lower than expected (Effect of COVID-19 lockdown on building industry)

✤Machinery and equipment historical spending tendencies reflect increased spending during the latter part of a financial year as delivery of vehicles (major portion) takes place. (This is a normal trend and under expenditure of this item is not a real risk.) Previous delivery trends underwrite this inference.




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




Percentage of arrests of identified transnational crime suspects facilitated, in relation to requests received from INTERPOL member countries
