FINAL MANDATE ON THE *DIVISION OF REVENUE SECOND AMENDMENT BILL*[B24 – 2020]

1. INTRODUCTION

The Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism, Hon N Maneng, tabled the Committee's negotiating mandate on the *Division of Revenue Second Amendment Bill* [B24 – 2020], as adopted by the Portfolio Committee on Tuesday, 24 November 2020.

2. PROCESS FOLLOWED

- 2.1 The Speaker of the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature has on receipt of the Bill referred the *Division of Revenue Second Amendment Bill, 2020* to the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism.
- 2.2 On the Thursday, 12 November 2020, the Select Committee on Appropriations together with Portfolio Committees on Finance received a briefing on the Bill from National Treasury.
- 2.3 No physical public hearings could be conducted due to Covid-19 lockdown restrictions. However, a request was forwarded to all stakeholders in all regions of the Northern Cape Province on Thursday, 12 November 2020 for written inputs on the Bill.
- 2.4 Furthermore, a request for written submissions/inputs on the Bill were advertised on all social media platforms of the Provincial Legislature, namely: Twitter, Facebook and Instagram on 17 November 2020. The request was also announced on news bulletins of Radio Riverside, Upington on 19-20 November 2020.

3. PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE POSITION AT THE NEGOTIATING STAGE

The Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism **supports** the Bill.

The House conferred on the Permanent Delegates the authority to participate in negotiations and to raise the concerns expressed.

4. COMMITTEE POSITION AFTER CONSIDERATION OF NEGOTIATING MANDATE BY THE NCOP SELECT COMMITTEE

The Portfolio Committee's Negotiating Mandate indicated that the Northern Cape will support the *Division of Revenue Second Amendment Bill* [B24 – 2020].

5. DISSENTING VIEW/S IN TERMS OF RULE 100(3) OF THE NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE

The Democratic Alliance does not support the Bill for the reasons as provided during the negotiating mandate stage.

The Economic Freedom Fighters also do not support the Bill.

6. FINAL VOTING MANDATE

In terms of Section 65 of the Constitution, the Portfolio Committee on Finance, Economic Development & Tourism recommends that the House confer authority on the Head of its Delegation to the NCOP to vote in support of the *Division of Revenue Second Amendment Bill* [B24 – 2020].
