

- 7. It is therefore my emphasis herein that you are kindly requested not to action nor to take into consideration the contents of MEC Boitumelo Moiloa letter dated 02 September 2020 which are misleading and one sided.

8. Should you proceed to action nor declare vacancy in line with the disputed court order, I hold firm advice to approach a competent court of law on urgent basis to exercise my Constitutional right amongst the others, shall request a Court order against your good self and your institution.
