


ECONOMIC IMPACT OF WINE TOURISM




- R7.2 billion contribution to GDP in 2019





Will the measure achieve the objective?

Stated objective: To enhance road traffic safety

Chosen measure to achieve objective: Reduction of legal BAC to zero

Not disputed: That alcohol plays a major role in road traffic injuries and deaths and that steps need to taken to enhance road safety

Disputed: Whether this specific regulatory measure (zero BAC) will achieve the stated objective

What is at risk?

What is at risk? jobs and rural economies

- Wine tourism is unique in its ability to attract tourists to district and rural areas
- The introduction of a zero BAC limit will make wine tourism almost entirely impossible, especially in the most rural areas.

The consequence:

This measure will have a <u>disproportionately</u> negative impact on wine tourism and the rural economies supported by wine tourism.

A disproportionate burden?

Is there proportionality between the desired policy objective and the proposed measure?

- Will this measure achieve the desired objective? Is there another way to achieve the same objective disproportionately burdening small businesses?
- <u>South Africa's current BAC level is in line with international standards.</u> Therefore is it the BAC level that be changed? Or does this point to other challenges, that need more targeted interventions?
- The effective enforcement of current rules, and the implementation of targeted policies to change identified problem areas (e.g. zero tolerance for novice drivers or measures targeting pedestrian better than a blanket measure which has a <u>disproportionately</u> negative impact on jobs and the rural
