I have received the annual salary recommendations for the public office bearers including members of the Independent Constitutional Institutions, judges and magistrate from the Independent Commission for the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers (the Commission).


The Commission having considered, amongst others, the fiscal condition of the country, the State's wage bill and the impact of Public Office Bearers' salary increment on the fiscus and general economic status of the country which has been negatively affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, affordability of the fiscus, recommended 0% salary increment for all public office bearers including members of the Independent Constitutional Institutions, judges and magistrates for the financial year 2020 /2021

In term of section 9(1) of the Financial and Fiscal Commission Act, 1997 (Act No. 99 of 1997), members of the Financial and Fiscal Commission are entitled to an annual salaries and such allowances, or benefits as determined by the President; from time to time, by notice in the *Gazette*, and approved by the National Assembly.

Having considered the Commission's recommendations and serious economic challenges facing the country, I am intending to determine 0% salary increment for members of the FFC

The National Assembly is requested to consider and approve the attached draft notice.
