



ADOPT THE CLIMATE JUSTICE CHARTER!

- We are a diverse movement
- 262 organizations-and counting- have endorsed the CJC
- The CJC is the world's first climate justice Charter
- ▶ 16 October 2020 we handed over the CJC to parliament for adoption
- ▶ 16 October 2021 Parliament representative attended our Assembly, we reiterated our call to adopt the charter.
- We call on parliament to adopt the CJC as per section 234 of the constitution



The bill violates section 24 of the constitution

- The right to an environment that is not harmful to human health will be violated by the extraction of harmful Greenhouse Gases
- Coal bed methane gas extraction will require extensive use of groundwater
- The bill undercuts the ecologically sustainable development envisaged in section 24 of the constitution by providing the legal framework and justification to an ecologically unsustainable industry.




The bill is an intergenerational crime

- We have a moral and 'existential' duty to protect the earth for future generations
- The exploration of oil and gas through seismic exploration will destroy our marine life and marine biodiversity
- The bill does not pass the morally permissible standard of risk imposition in environmental intergenerational ethics



There are cheaper and sustainable alternatives

- Ooffshore wind energy can supply 2 387,08 terawatt-hours of electricity annually; that that is eight times our current energy needs
- The costs of renewable energy systems and unit costs of renewable energy generation have come down dramatically in comparison to fossil fuels.
- The International Energy Agency says there should be no new development in oil and gas if the world is to achieve netzero by 2050
- Investments in renewable energy more than double in comparison to investments in fossil fuels



Climatic Tipping Points

- Southern Africa is already warming at about twice the global rate of temperature increase
- ► As the world reaches 1.5° this decade, we will be at 3° overshoot.
- We will see climate famines, more climate refugees and inevitable, many people will die
- Climate shocks are increasing in frequency and severity.
- ► Carbon Dioxide level reached a record of 415 ppm in 2021
- the Amazon Rain forest is now emitting more carbon dioxide than it is absorbing
- Ice sheets are receding in the arctic, El Nino droughts more frequent
