- iii. UKZN submitted a comprehensive report directly to the Portfolio Committee

DUT

- i. SRC Related matters / Political instability
- ii. National Students Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS) delays
- iii. Student Housing
- iv. Ongoing engagements between Management and SRC to resolve issues.

UP

- i. Staff insourcing – resolved

UCT

- i. Student fee debt - removed fee block to allow academic deserving students to register

UFS

- i. Vaccine Mandate
- ii. National Students Financial Aid (NSFAS) delays
- iii. Ongoing engagements with student leadership.

NMU

- i. National Students Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS)I delays
- ii. Student fee debt - removed fee block to allow qualifying students to register
- iii. PG Funding – bursary scheme in place to assist deserving students to continue with their studies. (R600m)

# Conclusion

- a. Most of the factors that contributed to student unrest at individual universities points to the broader systemic issues which are covered in the written report by USAf.
- b. However, institutional specifics should be recognised.
- c. Universities / USAf are committed to on going engagements with relevant stakeholders to ensure stability in the sector.
