Objectives of the APP review

- The focus is on programmes that are directly linked to the mandate of the department, therefore the review was performed on all programmes with specific focus on one significant programme
- The review does not entail the performance of detailed procedures where the underlying systems and supporting documentation is inspected to give assurance on the verifiability of indicators and targets.



Scope of the review


Measurability of indicators and targets

Indicators are welldefined Indicators are verifiable

Targets are specific, measurable and time-bound.



Well-defined = clear, unambiguous definition so that data will be collected consistently and will be easy to understand and use.



Specific = the nature and the required level of performance can be clearly identified

Measurable = the required performance can be measured

Time bound = the time period or deadline for delivery is specified
