RE: PUBLIC PROTECTOR / SPEAKER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND OTHERS

We write to you again in your capacity as the Chair of the Section 194 Committee. We refer to our earlier letter to you dated 23 March 2022, to which this is a follow-up.

We deem it necessary to give you an update of developments since we wrote our previous letter to you, which are:

1. As you may be aware, through their legal representatives, the Public Protector, the President and the Speaker have reached an in-principle agreement that the urgent

application referred to in our previous correspondence to you and to him be set down for hearing before a Full Court of three Judges on 25 and/or 26 April 2022. This is obviously subject to the approval of the Judge President, as well as some minor outstanding issues regarding the exchange of pleadings and heads of argument.

2. Pending the outcome of the said application, the President has agreed to impose a moratorium on the proposed suspension process until the court declares whether or not he is the lawful suspending authority in the prevailing circumstances.
3. The application papers, if any, will only be served after the outcome of your Committee's meeting of 29 March 2022 has been communicated to us, hopefully in line with the timelines set out in our previous letter, ie by 10h00 on 30 March 2022.
4. If the Committee also decides to halt its proceedings pending the outcome of the application regarding the implications of the institution of the rescission application and/or Rule 89 of the NA Rules, then this will have a significant bearing on whether or not to institute the application, the identity of the respondents and/or the ambit and nature of the application, if any.
5. If, on the other hand, the Committee decides to forge ahead with its programme in spite of the pending litigation, then the future conduct of the matter and the disputed lawfulness or otherwise thereof will be determined in the course of the envisaged court processes and out of our hands.

Kindly table this letter and all the relevant correspondence which has been furnished to you by the Speaker, for discussion at the meeting on 29 March 2022, as the outcome thereof will have a significant impact on the next steps by the Public Protector and/or all other interested parties to whom this letter will also be copied.


