Gender Based Violence and Femicide(GBVF) Action Plan

• <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

The GBVF action plan is informed by the Multi-Party Women's Caucus(MPWC) identification of Gender Based Violence and Femicide(GBVF) as a priority focus area, as well as the following:

- Expressed need for the MPWC to be a social activism based structure that empowers women at all levels,
- Expressed need for the MPWC to conduct oversight and check on progress in relation to reports by various departments on implementation of the Pillars of the National Strategic Plan on GBVF(NSP-GBVF).

The recent assent of GBVF laws has further encouraged the MPWC to resolve to embark on initiatives in all provinces to empower communities about these laws.

PROPOSED PLAN OF ACTION

Focus areas

The GBVF action plan to focus on two areas by combining empowerment (awareness raising) on GBVF legislation and oversight as follows:

- Focus Area 01: Empowering communities about gender based violence and femicide laws.
- Focus Area 02: Oversight on implementation of pillars of NSP- GBVF, as reported on by various Departments.

• Engagements before conducting visits

Acknowledging the importance of partnering with key stakeholders in various provinces as well as being fully prepared prior conducting provincial visits, the Multi Party Women's Caucuses will:

- Engage the Department of Justice and Correctional Services on readiness to implement the recently assented GBVF laws as well as date of commencement of these laws.
- Engage with Provincial Legislatures and Municipal Councils Women's Caucuses about identification of communities and available relevant stakeholders for the planned initiatives. Relevant stakeholders to include civil society organisations (including men's formations, organisations for persons with disabilities and LGBTQIA+), tertiary institutions, traditional leaders, religious bodies, and any other available relevant stakeholder in selected areas. Provincial Legislatures and Municipal Councils Women's Caucuses will assist in planning and implementation of this GBVF Action Plan.
