**RE: APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR  
CORRECTIONAL SERVICES (NCCS) IN TERMS OF SECTION 83(2)(h) ACT  
111/1998**

### **Introduction**

As you may be aware, I am mandated to appoint a National Council for Correctional Services (Council) in terms of Section 83 of the Correctional Services Act, 1998 (Act 111 of 1998).

The main function of this Council is to advise me on policies and developments within the corrections system and sentencing processes.

The Council has historically (dating as far back as the old Act of 1959) been very instrumental in the development of processes and procedures within the Correctional and Penology field nationally and outside our Borders.

The Council also considers cases of offenders serving sentences of life imprisonment and must make recommendations to me regarding the placement of such offenders on parole or day parole and cancellation of day parole or parole. Certain members of the Council also sit as the Correctional Supervision and Parole Review Board, to review the decisions of Parole Boards.

The term of the current Council was extended until **30 June 2022**.

It is clear from Section 83 of Act 111 of 1998 that the composition of this Council has to be reflective of the dynamics of our country, as far as the Administration of Justice and Public Safety is concerned. It is legislated that the Council must consist of the following persons:

- (i) Three Judges of the High Court or Supreme Court of Appeal;
- (ii) A Magistrate;
- (iii) A prosecutor from the National Prosecuting Authority;
- (iv) Representatives from the Departments of Correctional Services, Social Development and Police;
- (v) Two persons who specialise in the field of corrections; and lastly
- (vi) Members of the community. (As per the Act, four or more members)

For the purpose of this communication, I will limit my discussion to the appointments as far as they relate to Section 83(h), appointments which must be made in consultation with the relevant Parliamentary Committees. (National Assembly and NCOP)

**Discussion**

I deem it necessary to perhaps start by advising on the areas I'd like the Council to focus on. I must indicate that COVID 19 has had a negative impact in our

Department, country and worldwide. In our corrections environment, we've had to seriously consider, adopt and implement various strategies with the aim of managing this pandemic, such as the boosting of hygiene, health and other essential services for our offenders. Policy amendments and development, in line with institutional best norms and practices have to be adopted to ensure the management and reduction of COVID cases in our facilities.

Secondly, the creation of self-sufficiency and sustainability model in our Correctional Facilities is a priority. With National fiscus being regularly prioritised on other competing priorities it goes without saying that the time has come for us to develop self-sufficient centres through environmentally friendly practices without compromising public safety. Research and policy development is urgently needed in this area.

Lastly, Section 78 of Act 111 of 1998, states that the Council will also be seized with the responsibility of advising me in respect of the powers I have in relation to offenders serving life sentences.

**Appointments in terms of s83(2)(h)**

An advert was published in the Sunday media on 16 June 2019 with a closing date of 5 July 2019. A further advert was published on 6 October 2019 with a closing date of 21 October 2019 with the aim of increasing the pool of the candidates for appointment.

Following in-house consultation and needs based research; I have decided to limit my appointments to the legal, religious, academic, community involvement and social fields.

I now hereby propose that the relevant Parliamentary Committees consider the following candidates for appointment:

**Legal Fraternity**

- Ms Amanda Lindokhuhle Vilakazi: age 34 years, Female, an admitted Attorney based in Johannesburg and currently serving as a member of the NCCS
- Adv Yvette Le Roux: age 46 years, Female, an Adv of the High Court of SA based in the Eastern Cape
- Adv Khavhareni Aarone Mahumane: age 65 years, Male, Adv of the High Court of SA based in Limpopo
- Mr Marothi Aaron Mashifane: age 45 years, Male, an admitted Attorney, based in Pretoria (also representing persons with disability)
- Ms Ngenzeni Victoria Mboweni (Nkuna): age 35 years, Female, an admitted Attorney based in Mpumalanga
- Mr Tshepo Nawane: age 41 years, Male, an admitted Attorney based in Johannesburg

**The religious fraternity**

- Rev Pogiso France Mookisi: age 58 years, Reverend in the Apostolic Faith Mission based in Pretoria.

**Academics with experience in criminal justice**

- Dr Lineo Rose Johnson: age 60 years, Doctor of Education based in Pretoria, involved in various projects and activities working closely with the Department of Correctional Services on educational programmes that benefit women offenders. She was also working with the Department in the establishment of the Unisa Hub. She will be assisting the department with the training of professionals in the Department.
- Mr Mziwoxolo Mfeketo: age 68 years, based in Western Cape, and completed Masters in Administration. He has served as a member of the

NCCS from 2016 till to date. He is involved in various community development programmes.

**Community Representative**

- Mr Maluleka Nkopo: aged 71 years of age from Western Cape. He obtained Diplom-Jura from Humboldt University in Berlin and has done LLB. He is the current member of the NCCS and has been part of projects aimed at uplifting communities.

**Criminologist**

- Dr Vanitha Chetty: age 71 years, a female who specializes in criminology which is a scarce skill in the Correctional Services environment and is based in Durban. Her experience, skills and specialization are relevant to the work of the NCCS as she is currently serving on the NCCS.
- Ms Vuyelwa K Maweni: 30 years of age from KwaZulu-Natal. With Masters in Social Science majoring in Criminology and Forensic Studies and Doctor of Philosophy candidate. She is lecturing forensic criminology and has worked with the Department of Correctional Services on risk profiling and community profiling.

**Social Workers**

- Ms Daleen Van Biljon: age 48 years from Eastern Cape, female with Masters in Forensic Social Work, with extensive experience in Social Work, Restorative Justice and Victim Empowerment.
- Dr Yolinda Steyn: aged 48 years from Free State, female with Doctorate in Social Work, with 23 years experience in Social Work.

**Psychologists:**

- Mr Willem A.A. Hanekom: 68 years of age from Western Cape. A Clinical Psychologist with a Masters Degree and experience in the Department of Correctional Services and private practice.
- Ms Lusanda U.Z. Rataemane: 67 years of age based in Gauteng. A Clinical Psychologist with Masters Degrees obtained from University Surrey. She is the current member of the NCCS.

The new Council will be appointed with effect from **01 July 2022** for a period of five years.

**Annual Budget allocation:**

It is important to indicate that the budget of the Council is controlled by the Council's Secretariat which is employed by the Department. It for this reason that Act 111 of 1998 does not require appointment of an Accountant as a member of the Council.

**Council allowances:**

- The Council allowances (R2 619-00) per session (per day) are paid from the Compensation of Employees budget from the Department to members of the Council who are not in the service of the State. Attached hereto as **Annexure A** is a breakdown of allowances paid to members during 2020/2021 financial year.

**Council: Goods and Services budget:**

- The budget allocated below is used for the running costs of the Council's Secretariat. (**Annexure B**)
