### **BACKGROUND**

- The LandCare programme is a community based natural resources management programme implemented through the concurrent function as per schedule 4 of the Constitution.
- The National Department is responsible for the financial administration and setting of environment while Provinces are responsible for development and implementation of projects.







### **BACKGROUND** Continue

- Four Provinces namely GP, LP, NC and NW were selected and an invitation was extended to the MECs responsible for the sector.
- The DALRRD implements the LandCare programme to attain the Conservation of Agricultural Resources Act, 43 of 1983 mandate of maintaining the production potential of land.
- The LandCare goal is to optimize productivity and enhance the sustainable use of natural agricultural resources







### Six Indivisible LandCare Principles

- Integrated Sustainable Natural Resource Management embedded within a holistic policy and strategic framework where the primary causes of natural resource decline are recognized and addressed.
- Fostering group or community based and led natural resource management within a participatory framework that includes all land users, both rural and urban, so that they take ownership of the process and the outcomes.
- The development of <u>sustainable livelihoods</u> for individuals, groups and communities utilizing empowerment strategies.
- Government, community and individual <u>capacity building</u> through targeted training, education and support mechanisms.
- The development of active and true <u>partnerships</u> between governments, LandCare groups and communities, non-government organizations and industry.
- The blending together of appropriate upper level policy processes with bottom up feedback mechanisms.

### LANDCARE PROCESSES

- The LandCare Guidelines for project development is provided to the provinces.
- The Provinces compile business plans, hold Provincial Assessment Panel (PAP) and submits to DALRRD.
- The National Secretariat analyse the submitted business plans for compliance to the guidelines and identifies the gaps. The feedback is then forwarded to the province to amend the respective business plans.







### LANDCARE PROCESSES

- The National Assessment Panel (NAP) is held to assess and provide recommendations. The NAP feedback letters are forwarded to provinces for amendments. Once these corrections are done, the business plans are returned to National.
- The request for approval of the National Business Plan is submitted to the Director General of DALRRD.
- Once DG's approval is granted, National Treasury and provinces are notified.







### LANDCARE PROCESSES

- Provinces will then implement projects with LandCare committee, partners and communities.
- National Secretariat, Provincial Coordinator, and other provincial M&E and any other officials dealing with natural resources management including Internal Audit section will monitor the implementation of LandCare projects.

# OVERVIEW OF LANDCARE FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE 2021/2022

- LandCare Annual Budget = R 83,337,000.00
- Transferred = R 80,578,000.00
- Expenditure = R 74,581,168.00
- GP only received R 2,257,000.00 from annual allocation of R 5,016,000.00.
- Unspent transferred amount R 5, 996 832
- This was due to unsatisfactory financial performance by the provinces.







# OVERVIEW OF LANDCARE FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE 2022/2023

- The National business plan comprising of seven provinces (except GP & MP) were approved on the 08 June 2022. The business plans for GP & MP were not received during NAP.
- LandCare Annual Budget = R 84,920,000.00
- Transferred = R 4,941,000.00 (FS,LP,KZN,WC & NW)
- Expenditure = R3,543,041.00 (KZN, LP & WC)

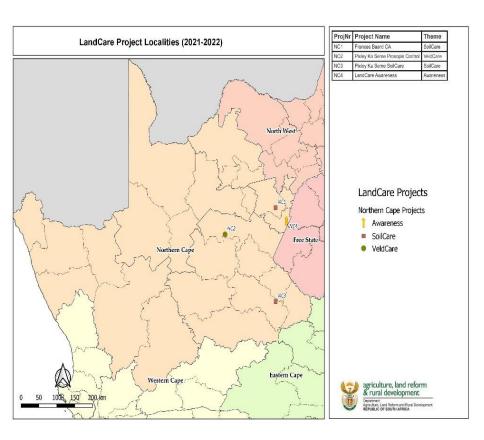


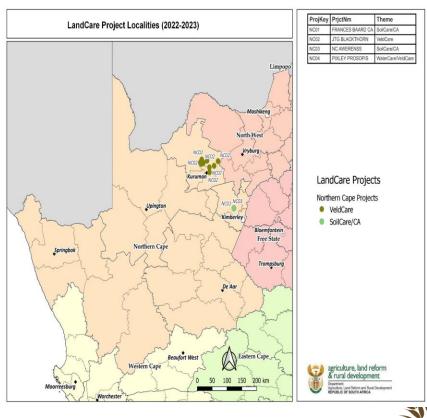






### NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE PROJECTS



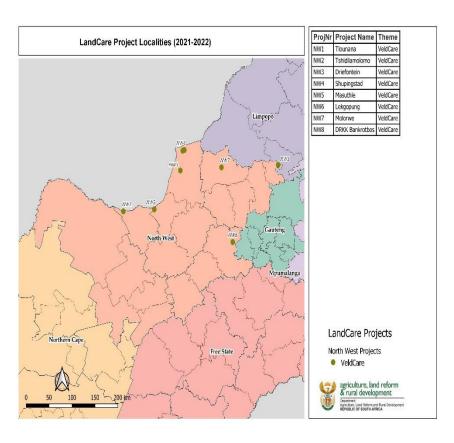


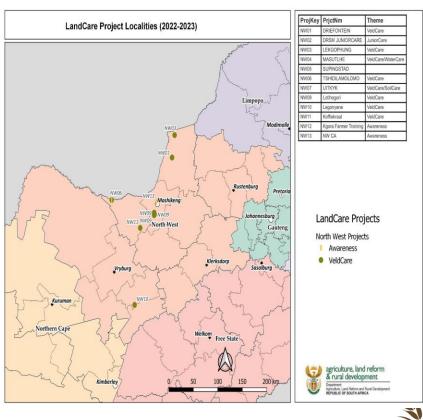

- Overall LandCare Annual Budget 2022/23 is R 84,920,000.00 of which DALRRD transferred a total of R 25, 757,550.00 to Free State, Limpopo, Kwa-Zulu Natal, Northern Cape, North West and Western Cape with reported expenditure of

R5,305, 756.00







#### **CONCLUDING REMARKS**

- That the overall LandCare Annual Budget for 2022/23 is R 84,920,000.00 of which DALRRD has already transferred a total of R 25, 757,550.00 to Free State, Limpopo, Kwa-Zulu Natal, Northern Cape, North West and Western Cape with reported expenditure of R5,305, 756.00
- LandCare programme responds to a number of South Africa's country United Nation Convention to Combat Desertification, United Nation Framework Convention for Climate Change and related Sustainable Development Goal's commitments in particular SDG 2.4 on putting half of agricultural land under sustainable practices and SDG 15.3 regarding avoidance, minimisation and reversal of land

degradation.







#### **CONCLUDING REMARKS**

- That there is a need to consider each Province and communities peculiar context when providing support since each Province has its unique needs, which may require more funding than the LandCare programme can provide. These varied needs range from Conservation Agriculture mechanization to the need to cultivate different adaptable fodder species.
- Request Committee to note and consider the Provincial expenditure and performance outputs and make further guidance if necessary.
