

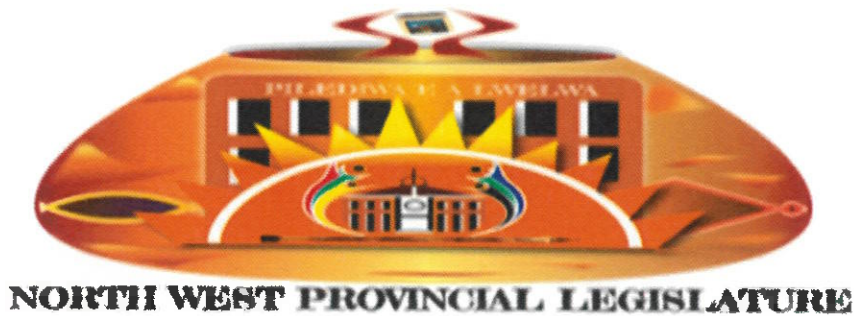

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

1. Pg 25 of the Bill; An amount of R 111 million allocated to the North West Province on Provincial Roads Maintenance Grant is not sufficient to construct and rehabilitate roads in the province, considering the current conditions and quality of the roads maintenance in the North West. It is therefore proposed that such allocation be increased with 10% as compared to the R 589 million and R 320 million allocated to Eastern Cape and KwaZulu-Natal provinces respectively.
2. Pg 25 of the Bill; Schedule 4 Part A – North West is not included the Welisizwe Rural Bridges whereas most of our bridges where affected by the disaster.
3. Pg 38 of the Bill; The North West Municipalities are only allocated an adjusted allocation of R 163 025 on Infrastructure Grant Allocations to Municipalities, and there is no allocation Informal Settlement Upgrading Partnership Grant for 2022/23, whereas are huge backlogs of RDP houses in various municipalities in the Province.
4. Inadequate allocation towards Safety and Security, vehicles and police stations and to also an allocation towards increasing employing South African Police personnel in order to mitigate crime rate within the North West Province.
