**PUBLIC SCHOOL
SECTION 16A: FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY OF PRINCIPAL**

Governance and professional management of Public Schools.(1) subject to this Act. The governance of every public school is vested in its governing body and it may perform only such functions and obligations and exercise only such right as prescribed by the Act. Point of submission for change is that the school manager (Principal) Act on both as the Ex-officio, Accounting officer and as the member of the SGB. The question is doesn't this cause conflict of interest?

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF SGB MEMBERS SECTION 16.

Wording as per section 20(3) the Governing Body may join a Voluntary Association Representing Governing Bodies of Public Schools. As an Association we feel that may can be replaced by the word must which in principle it will strengthen the Law rather than giving SGB members option of choice either to join or not to join. Supporting statement is that most of the SGB members who does not belong to Association lack capacity building.

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
