MOTION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY – RECOMMENDATIONS ARISING FROM THE REPORT OF THE PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE TOURISM ON BUDGET VOTE 38: TOURISM

I draw your attention to the motion of the National Assembly which was adopted on 30 May 2023.

Accordingly, the Assembly approved the referral to the Standing Committee on Appropriations the following matters for consideration and report:

- (a) The budget for Vote 38: Tourism be approved but no further funds must be transferred to South African Tourism until the following conditions have been met:
- (i) the targets in the Annual Performance Plan of South African Tourism have been revised;
 - (ii) the vacancies at executive level of South African Tourism are filled; and
 - (iii) the delegation of authority taken by the Board in the letter of 27 April 2023 has been reversed and given back to the executives at South African Tourism.

Please note that these matters were extracted from the recommendations in the report of the Portfolio Committee on Tourism on Budget Vote 38: Tourism. The procedure in the Money Bills Amendment Procedure and Related Matters Act (Act No.9 of 2009) envisages that a committee proposing changes to a money bill or budget vote must consult with the Standing Committee on Appropriations, which is the committee that can finally amend the Bill. The budget may only be amended by way of the procedure set out in the Act.

Kindly forward a report of the Standing Committee on Appropriations on its position regarding these conditions as set out by the Portfolio Committee.
