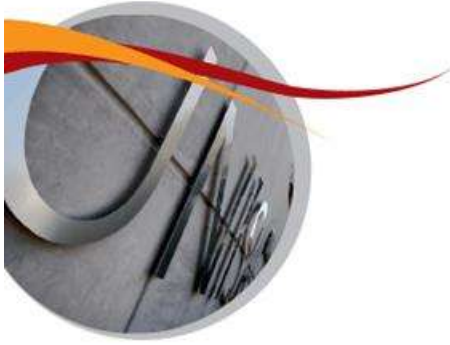

Following the site visit to the VC University house today, which I thought would have been completed by now, I had a number of concerns which I need you to follow up on. I must state I CANNOT accept such high amounts of money which are quoted for normal curtains that could cost less than a quarter of what's quoted. I cannot understand nor agree that the curtains should cost R275 000.00 . This is absurd. I also was really troubled for furniture for one room costing R400 000.00...Does the team understand that we are a Public University supported by the taxes of the poor and thus require being sensitive to our expenditure? Kindly intervene and ensure that such superfluous spending is not done in my name. Please Prof. Mothata engage your team and if possible, investigate whether they are not colluding with suppliers to inflate prices! I'm rather concerned and somewhat disappointed.
