The Portfolio Committee on Infrastructure, Roads, Transport and Human led by Committee Chairperson Hon. M.S Moleleki will conduct Public Hearings on the above-mentioned Bills.

National Road Traffic Amendment Bill [B7B-2020]

To amend the National Road Traffic Act, 1996, so as to insert new definitions and to amend others, to provide for the suspension and cancellation of the registration of an examiner for driving licences or an examiner of vehicles, if such person has been convicted of an offence listed in Schedule 1 or 2 of the Criminal Procedure Act, 1977 (Act No. 51 of 1977), or has a direct or indirect conflict of interest, to provide for the registration and grading of training centres.

National Land Transport Amendment Bill [B7E-2016]

To amend the National Land Transport Act, 2009, to insert certain definitions and amend others, to provide for non-motorised and accessible transport; to bring the Act up to date with developments since the implementation of the Act; to provide for certain powers of provinces to conclude contracts for public transport services; to expand the powers of the Minister to make regulations and introduce safety measures.
