## FINAL MANDATE FOR THE NATIONAL ROAD TRAFFIC AMENDMENT BILL [B7D-2020]

### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee on Transport, Safety & Liaison and Roads & Public Works, Hon L Senye, tables the Committee's mandate on the **National Road Traffic Amendment Bill, [B7D-2020]** as adopted by the Portfolio Committee on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023, as the Negotiating Mandate and on 20 November 2023 as the **Final Mandate**.

### 2. PROCESS FOLLOWED

- 2.1 The Speaker of the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature, referred the **National Road Traffic Amendment Bill, [B7D-2020]**, to the Portfolio Committee on Transport, Safety & Liaison and Roads & Public Works.
- 2.2 The Portfolio Committee received a briefing on the Bill on **12 May 2023**. The Northern Cape's Permanent Delegate to the NCOP, Hon K Mmoiemang gave a brief background of the bill, and an official, Mr. Johannes Makgatho from the National Department of Transport presented the National Road Traffic Amendment Bill.
- 2.3 The Portfolio Committee resolved at the meeting of 12 May 2023 to conduct public participation sessions to get inputs from the members of the public. The date was not decided upon. The public hearing was subsequently to be held on **18 May 2023** in Kimberley at the Legislature precinct. Both written and oral submissions were called for. Furthermore, radio adverts and jingles on radio stations were aired. An advert was developed for placement on the Institution's social media platforms as well as live reads, to solicit views of communities and stakeholders regarding the **National Road Traffic Amendment Bill, [B7D-2020]**. Members of the public from the different regions were bussed into Kimberley where the public hearing was held at the Legislature Ruth First Auditorium. The public engaged with the Members of the Provincial Legislature and the representatives from the National Department in respect of the Bill.
- 2.4 On 31 August 2023 the Portfolio Committee on the Portfolio Committee on Transport, Safety & Liaison and Roads & Public Works deliberated on the **National Road Traffic Amendment Bill, B7D-2020]**.

**3. PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE POSITION AT THE NEGOTIATING MANDATE STAGE**

The Portfolio Committee on Transport Safety & Liaison and Roads & Public Works supports the bill. The House confers on the Permanent Delegate the authority to participate in the negotiations and raise the concerns raised.

**4. COMMITTEE POSITION AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE NEGOTIATING MANDATE BY THE SELECT COMMITTEE**

The Portfolio Committee's Negotiating Mandate indicated that the Northern Cape supports the **National Road Traffic Amendment Bill, B7D-2020**.

**5. FINAL VOTING MANDATE**

In terms of Sect 65 of the Constitution, the Portfolio Committee Transport Safety & Liaison and Roads & Public Works recommends that the House confers authority on the Head of its delegation to the NCOP to vote in support of the **National Road Traffic Amendment Bill, B7D-2020**.
