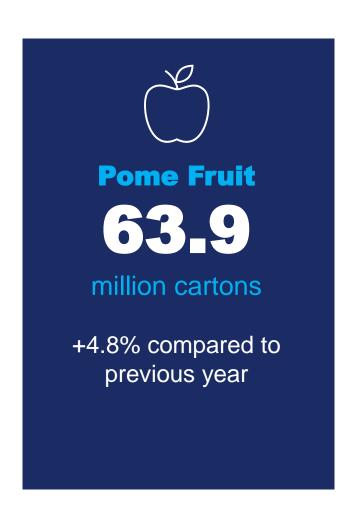

Inflation vs Levies

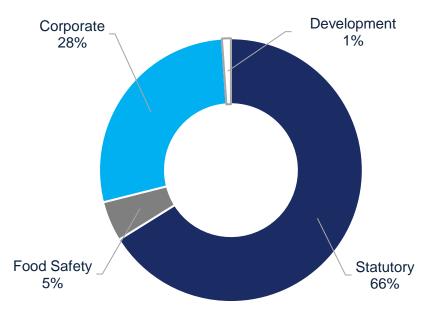
