The officers saw males drinking alcohol at a tavern situated at number 1081 Gama Street. The police approached the males to effect an arrest, however, the group started to attack the police and were allegedly joined by other members of the community in the attack against the officers. The police used rubber bullets to disperse the group however group (patriots) dispersed and some ran into the yards. It further reported that other police tried to arrest the deceased in this case but the deceased resisted an arrest instead managed to lock himself in the veranda of the house. The deceased's brother opened the veranda and begged the police to leave the premises. However, whilst the brother was speaking to the police one of the officers fired several shots to the deceased's brother using a shot gun (pump gun) at close range. The deceased died at the crime scene. There were visible wounds on the left side of the chin, two on the right chest and another deep wound on the left chest. The deceased was certified dead by the paramedics.	Suspects were arrested by IPID on the 29 March 2020. The Security Officer appeared before Court on the 31 March 2020 and he remain in Custody. He will appear on the 08 April 2020 for formal bail application. Investigation is proceeding as per NPA's instruction relating to the police officer. Crime scene reconstructed. All witness statements obtained. PM photos obtained. The case is still on the court roll, there are further directives from court for IPID to source additional information.
